Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
The far northwest of Scotland will have a largely sunny day but for most it will be overcast and damp. However, brightness is possible across western Wales and southwest England in the afternoon. Moderate showers are likely over southern and southeastern coastal areas later, spreading into eastern England overnight. By morning, persistent rain is expected across southwest England and Wales.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:  
Further rain is expected for many western parts of the UK on Wednesday and Thursday, heavy at times. It will be drier further east with some bright or sunny intervals. A southeasterly breeze will help temperatures to stay above average.
