Headline:

Southeast, mainly dry, bright spells. Heavy rain in northwest. Windy.

Today:

Northern Ireland, western Scotland, wet and windy with heavy rain and southerly gales in places. Elsewhere, a little rain in the north and west but most parts dry and bright with some hazy sunshine.

Tonight:

North, rain clearing eastwards then mainly dry but showers in west.
South, generally dry, broken cloud. Breezy.

Outlook for Wednesday:

Mostly dry and warm with bright or sunny spells.
