

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Rain will slowly clear the southeast, leaving most of England and Wales with scattered showers but also warm, sunny spells. Northern Britain will stay mostly cloudy with rain, sometimes heavy, particularly in Scotland. South-western parts will be breezy. Patchy rain in the north will continue overnight, turning heavy in places.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:
Tomorrow will be mainly cloudy but with some sunshine. Showers will affect most parts at times, and may be heavy and thundery in the far south. Eastern parts will be windy. There will be sunny spells and showers on Tuesday, possibly heavy in places. There will be a fresher feel.
