Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :
Feeling colder. Sunny periods and showers, some wintry on hills and heavy at times, especially across western Scotland. However central and eastern areas of Scotland and England will have the best sunshine and only a few showers. Breezy, risk of gales across far west and north Scotland.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:

Sunday: Wintry showers north and west Scotland. Rain, sleet and brisk winds will reach southwest England and may spread across other southern areas. Elsewhere mostly dry, sunny.

Monday: Cold. Rain and sleet across southern England will clear eastwards, probably turning to snow before clearing. Otherwise sunny periods and snow showers, mainly N.Ireland/Scotland/NE England.
