Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Storm Caroline will bring storm force winds to Scotland on Thursday, with frequent snow showers. Elsewhere, rain will clear through the morning to brighter but much colder weather, with strong northwesterly winds bringing snow showers into the north and west by evening.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Friday will be windy and bitterly cold with frequent snow showers in the north, west and some central areas giving local significant accumulations. Elsewhere the snow showers will be more isolated with sunny spells. There'll be a frosty start to Saturday, then sunshine, but further snow showers in the north and west, and perhaps north sea coastal areas.
