Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Early fog inland will gradually clear but is likely to persist around some western and eastern coasts. Most parts will start the day dry but showers are likely to break out during the morning, which could become heavy during the afternoon. Southeast England, Wales, Southwest England and Northern Ireland being most at risk.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Eastern England and Scotland will have a wet day on Tuesday with periods of heavy rain. Elsewhere it will be brighter with a few showers. Wednesday will start dry in most parts but outbreaks of rain will spread into western parts during the day.
