Headline:

Mainly dry, cloudy, misty. Brighter spells later. Light winds.

Today:

Most places cloudy, early fog over southern Scotland and Northern Ireland clearing slowly. Brighter spells may develop in England and Wales.

Tonight:

Apart from some drizzle in the far north, dry and rather cloudy. Frost and patchy fog are likely under clearer skies.

Outlook for Sunday:

Increasing wind, rain over the far north. Rather cloudy, some sunshine, elsewhere. Fog may be slow to clear.
