Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :
Any fog over Scotland should gradually clear. Outbreaks of rain over southern parts of England and Wales will move northwards, although Scotland and Northern Ireland should remain mostly dry with bright intervals. Temperatures near normal but becoming breezy in the north.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Wednesday will be dry in many southern and eastern areas, with some sunny intervals. However, cloud and rain will spread from the northwest across Scotland and Northern Ireland. Although southeast England may start cloudy on Thursday, with patchy rain, this will clear with sunny spells developing widely. However, the northwest will become windy with showers, making it feel cold.
