Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Rain and strong winds will sink across central and southern areas through the day. Brighter, cooler conditions will develop across the north with sunny spells emerging behind the rain. Scattered showers are likely in the far north. Frost and fog patches are likely to form overnight under clear spells. Cloud will thicken across the north with rain for the northwest.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

It will be a frosty start on Tuesday then a dry day for many central and southern parts. Strong winds are forecast across the north, with rain spreading across western areas. Wednesday will turn cold and windy with wintry showers.
