Headline:

Snow showers extending south, blizzards in north. Increasingly cold.

This Evening and Tonight:

Blizzards extending south across Scotland. Sleet/snow in S.Scotland moving south to reach S.England by evening, followed by clear spells inland and sleet/snow showers on western coasts/hills.

Wednesday:

Blizzard conditions spreading to NE.England. More persistent sleet/snow reaching northwest. Sunny intervals and snow showers elsewhere. Feeling bitterly cold in wind.

Outlook for Thursday:

Snow showers in north and east, sleet showers in west. Winds decreasing.
