Headline:

Rain clearing southeast England. Showers continuing over northwest Scotland. Elsewhere showers dying away, then dry, clear and chilly.

Wet and windy in north. Bright start in south, becoming increasingly cloudy, occasional rain mainly in western parts.

Outlook for Thursday:

Rather cloudy over England and Wales with occasional light rain. Rather warm in any sunny spells. Windy further north with sunny spells and showers.
