

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Fairly cloudy across the UK, with blustery showers for Scotland and Northern Ireland. England and Wales should be mostly dry and warm, with isolated light rain or showers. Remaining cloudy overnight with intermittent rain eventually reaching Wales, northern England, Scotland and Northern Ireland. Mostly dry elsewhere with light winds and clear spells, although fog may develop along the South Coast.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Rain may become heavy for a time across Scotland on Friday, with further spells of rain for northwestern parts of the UK on Saturday. It should be drier and warmer elsewhere with bright spells, especially in southeastern parts of England.
