

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Saturday 06 Sep 2014

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Rain across central areas becoming more showery. Further south mostly dry with warm sunny spells developing, though staying rather cloudy in the east. Sunny spells and some showers in the north, these locally heavy and thundery. Overnight, showers becoming confined to northeastern parts, where more persistent rain is possible later. Otherwise largely dry with clear periods and isolated fog patches.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Persistent and locally heavy rain affecting parts of northeastern Scotland on Sunday, and gradually petering out during Monday. Elsewhere, a good deal of dry and fine weather. Feeling warm in the sunshine, but the evenings and nights will be chilly.
