

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Sunny spells and scattered showers across northern parts today. Cloud and showers will push southwards across Wales and southern England through the day, with drier, brighter conditions following. Largely dry with late sunny, then clear spells tonight. However, cloud and rain will spread eastwards across Scotland and other exposed western areas.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Cloudy with rain across Scotland on Friday, heaviest in the northwest. Mostly cloudy over other western parts with some light rain, but largely dry and warm with occasional sunny spells elsewhere. Cloud and rain will affect northern and exposed western parts on Saturday with mostly fine, warm conditions elsewhere.
