

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Any low cloud in the south soon clearing to give some sunny spells, but becoming cloudier generally. Cloudy and breezy in the north with occasional rain, this persistent and locally heavy in northwest Scotland. Rain gradually moving southwards overnight, affecting Northern Ireland and southern Scotland by dawn. Showers following in far north. England and Wales largely dry with clear spells.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Rain continuing slowly southwards into northern England and Wales during Thursday, with some heavy bursts still likely, but rain generally fragmenting. Elsewhere, sunshine and showers, these most frequent and heaviest across Scotland. Friday, many places largely dry with sunny spells.
