

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Rather cloudy for most with a few outbreaks of rain in northern and western areas especially. Localised thunderstorms will also develop later across northeast Scotland. Meanwhile, staying drier and brighter in the far south and southeast until the evening when some heavy rain could affect these areas, whilst elsewhere a further light spells of rain could occur.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Rather cloudy initially on Thursday with some light rain or drizzle in places, then becoming increasingly dry and bright, but also with some thundery showers developing in the southeast. Friday should be the warmest day of the week, with plenty of fine weather.
