Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Often cloudy in the south with further spells of rain in the far southeast which may become heavy for a time. Brighter elsewhere with sunny spells but also scattered showers, some heavy with a risk of thunder. Chilly northerly winds. Tonight, becoming dry and cold under clearing skies with a touch of ground frost in places.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Tuesday, a cold start but some sunshine across central and southern areas and staying dry here. Cloudier in the north, some rain in the far northwest, this rain extending across other northern areas. Breezy on Wednesday with showers and longer spells of rain.
