

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:

A cold day with wintry showers confined mainly to the east. Light rain and snow will affect the far northwest for a time, whilst elsewhere, it will remain dry and bright. Overnight, cloud will thicken in the northwest bringing a little rain and sleet to Scotland and Northern Ireland. Wintry showers will ease across eastern England, with sharp frost elsewhere.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Thursday will be cloudy in the northwest, light rain edging southwards into northern England. Snow showers will become confined to southeast England, with drier and brighter conditions in the west. Mostly dry on Friday with snow flurries across southeastern parts.
