Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :
Northern areas will have a mostly dry, sunny day, although rather cold at first with widespread frost and patchy freezing fog. It will be cloudier in the far northwest, winds increasing here. Southern areas will stay cloudy and dull, with patchy drizzle in places, although perhaps the skies clearing in the southeast later. Temperatures mostly near average.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Thursday and Friday will be much colder, an easterly wind setting in. Southern and eastern areas will be mostly cloudy, with light rain and drizzle turning to light snow flurries over the two days, whilst western areas see some bright or sunny spells.
