SUMMARY OF BRITISH WEATHER

Overnight Scotland and Northern Ireland and Northern parts of England were wet and windy. The rain was heavy in places but was quickly followed by clearer conditions with blustery showers, there were gales in many northern areas. Across England and Wales it was mainly dry with just the odd spot of drizzle in places.

During the morning the winds eased in the north with Scotland having scattered showers. The Eastern side was brighter and drier.

Northern Ireland and Northern England were cloudy with outbreaks of rain or drizzle. Elsewhere the SW winds freshened, it was rather cloudy and there were some outbreaks of mainly light drizzle chiefly over Wales. Most of Scotland, Northern England and Northern Ireland had a cloudy afternoon with the showers giving way to more rain spreading from the west.

Wales and the rest of England was cloudy but mostly dry with some sunny spells in the extreme south.

England and Wales stayed cloudy and dry. Apart from the odd spot of drizzle in western areas.

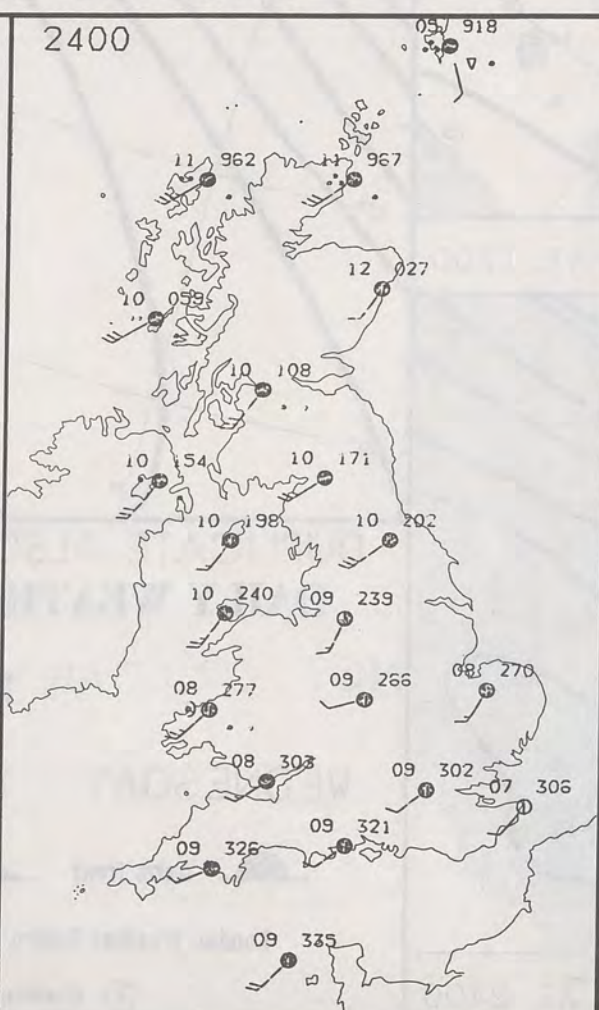
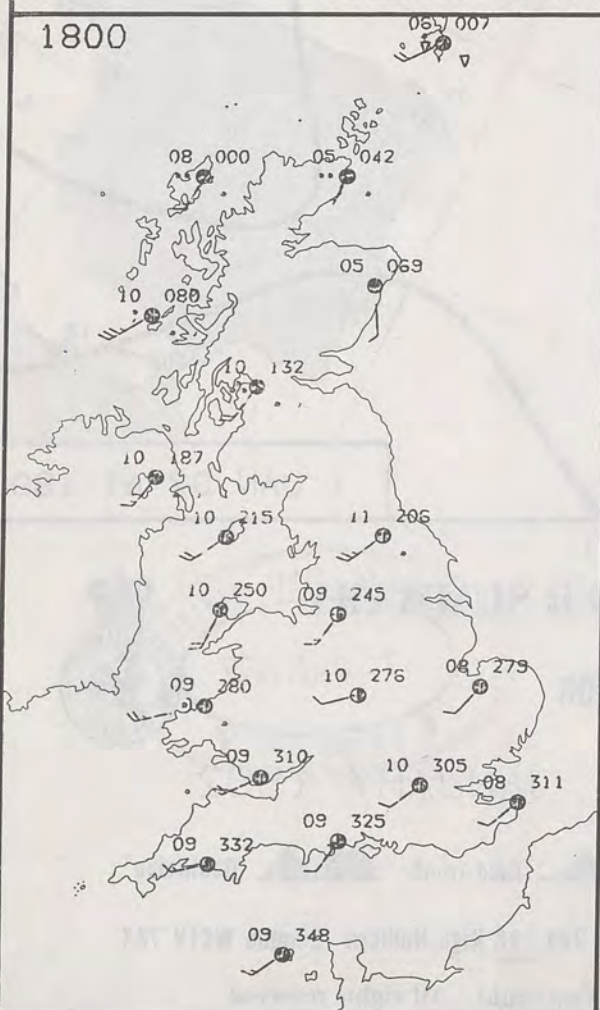
It was mostly mild or very mild but with strong winds in the north.

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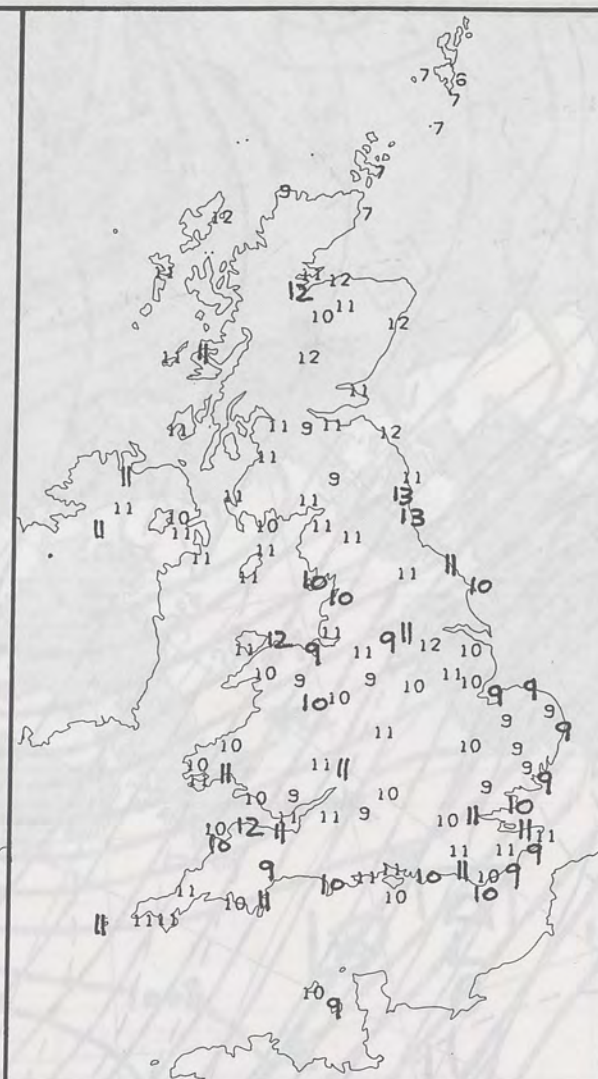
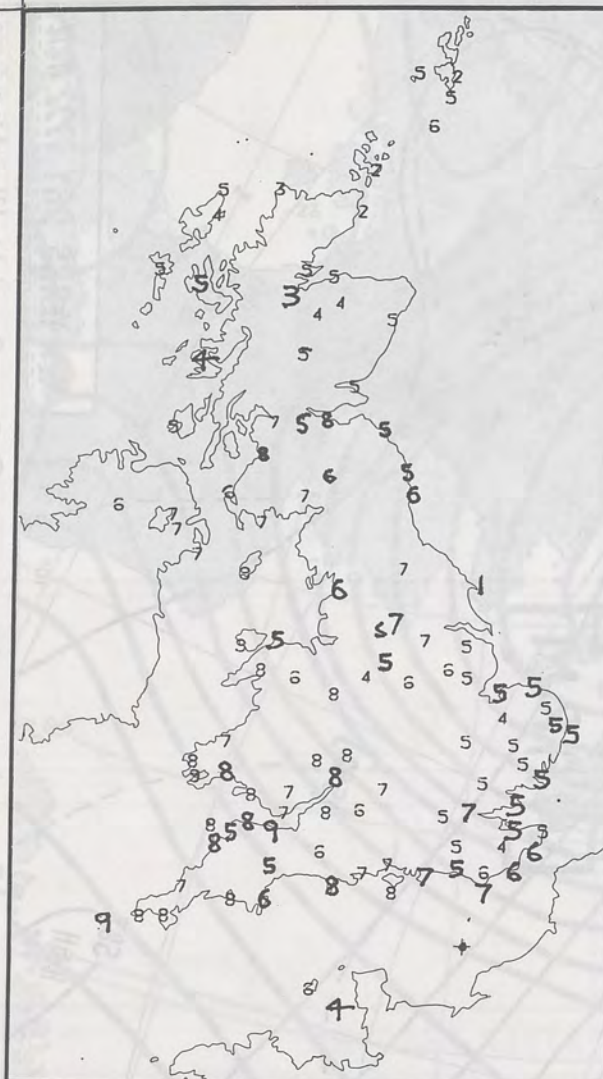


PLOTTED SURFACE OBSERVATIONS

SUMMARY OF BRITISH WEATHER

Overnight, Northern Ireland, Northern and Western parts of Scotland were cloudy and windy with outbreaks of rain. There were gales in many places. Eastern Scotland generally remained dry with some clear spells.

Much of England and Wales remained cloudy overnight, most parts were dry, although some western coasts and hills had some light drizzle at times.

During the day Northern Ireland and much of Scotland, excluding Eastern parts had further outbreaks of rain, some heavy in places. Gales continued to affect many parts as well. Eastern Scotland remained dry with some sunny spells and here it was less windy too.

England and Wales apart from some patchy light rain and drizzle in the west, had a dry but rather cloudy day with a fresh to strong SW,LY wind across most parts.

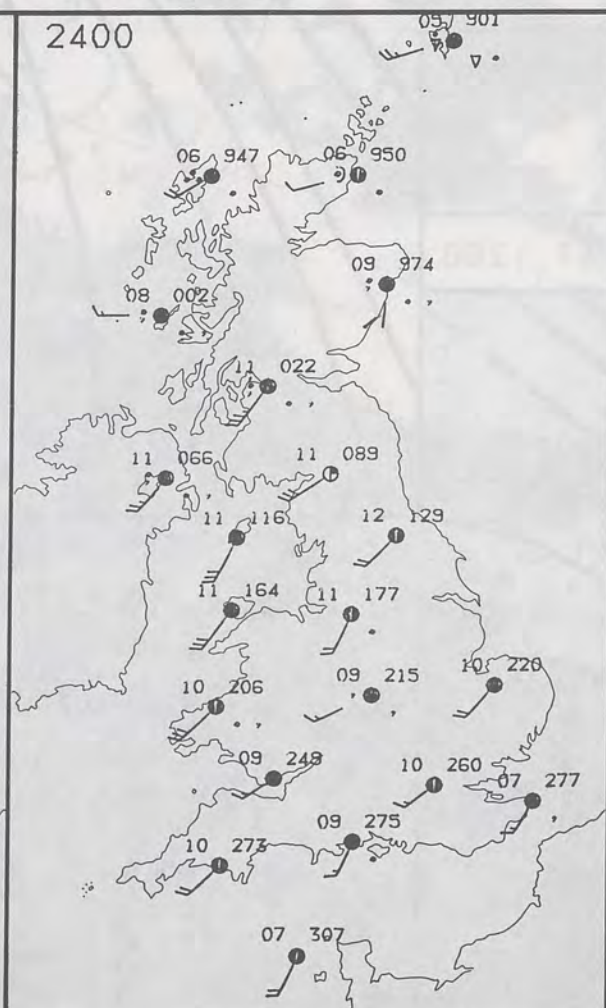
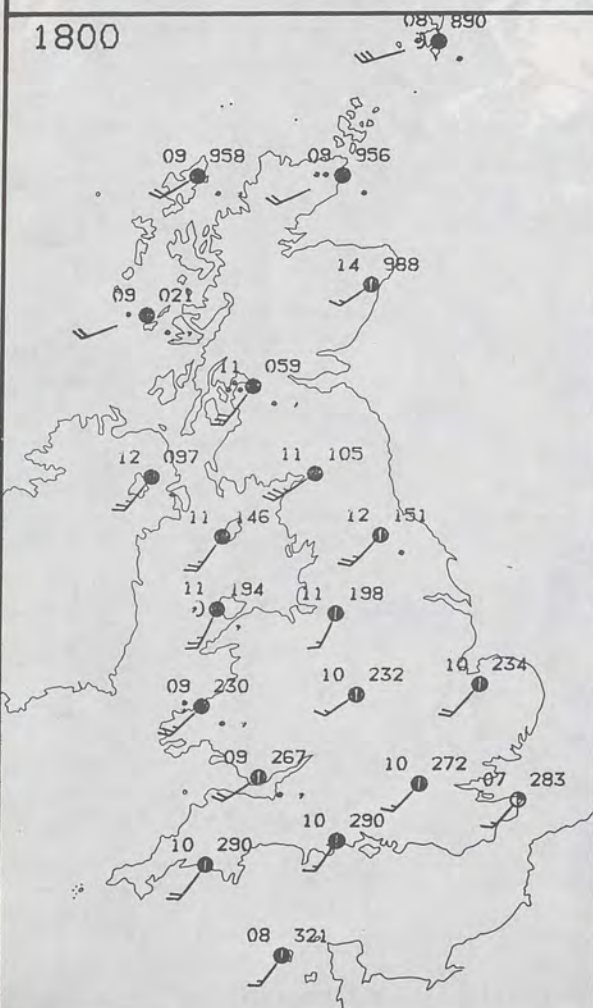
It was a very mild day almost everywhere and exceptionally mild over parts of Eastern Scotland.

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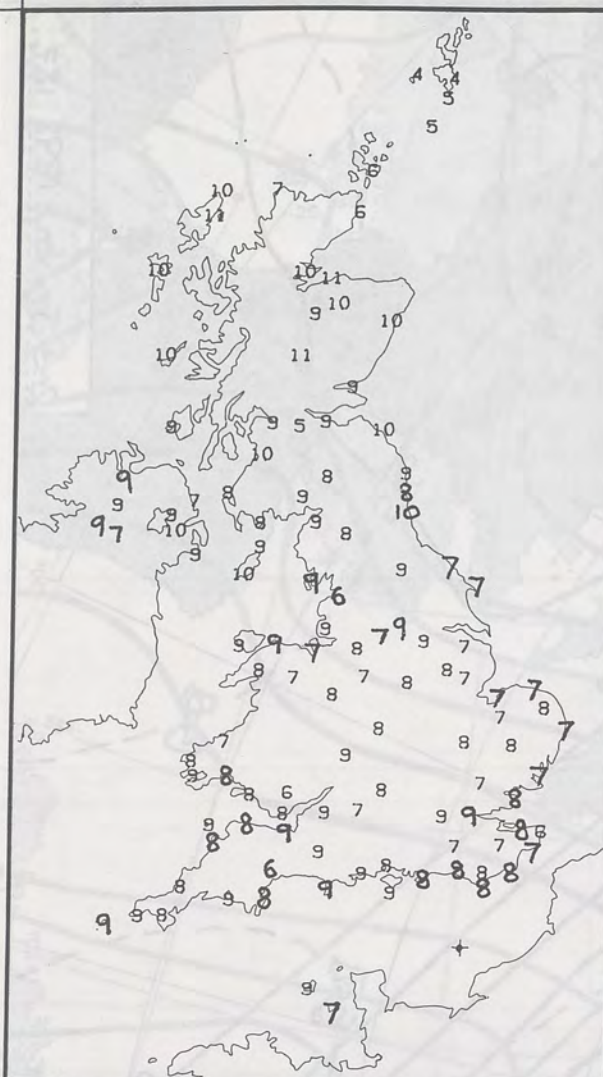

Much of Scotland and Northern Ireland had a wet and windy night with heavy rain in many places. there were also gales in many parts too. southeast Scotland started the night dry with clear spells, but by dawn rain had reached these parts too. at the same time, colder showery weather began to spread into the far northwest.

Apart from a little light rain or drizzle in a few places, much of England and Wales had a dry and rather cloudy night, and it was quite windy too, especially in the north and west.

The rain over much of Scotland and Northern Ireland, slowly edged southwards during the day, reaching Northern England and north Wales during the afternoon, and the Midlands and south Wales in the evening. Following on behind was somewhat colder showery weather from the northwest, which had extended across much of Scotland and Northern Ireland by evening. Some of the showers were heavy with hail and falling as snow on the hills. the rest of England and Wales, had a generally dry and rather cloudy day. It was windy everywhere with gales affecting many NW parts of England and Wales.

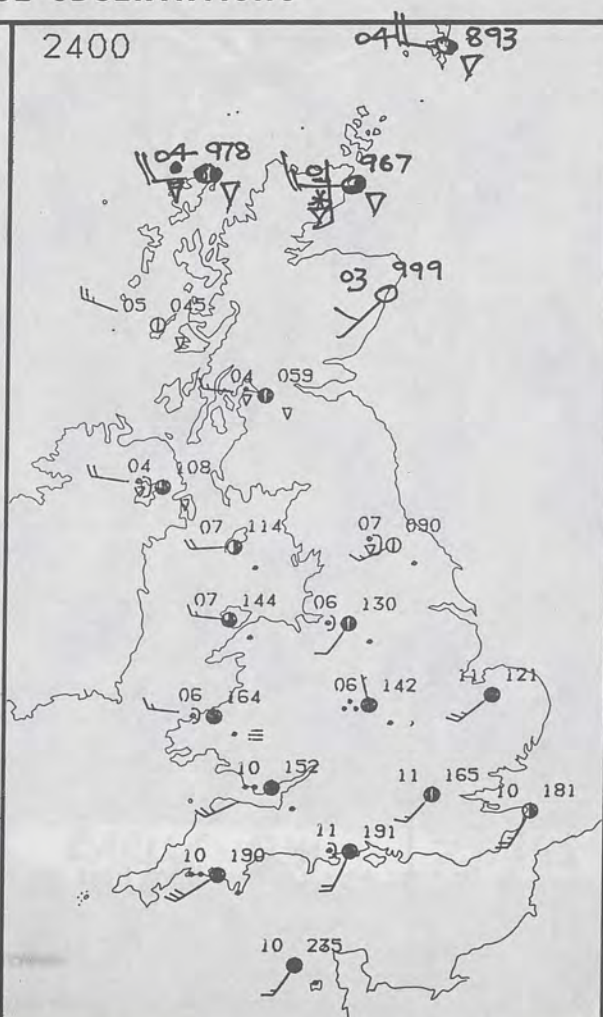
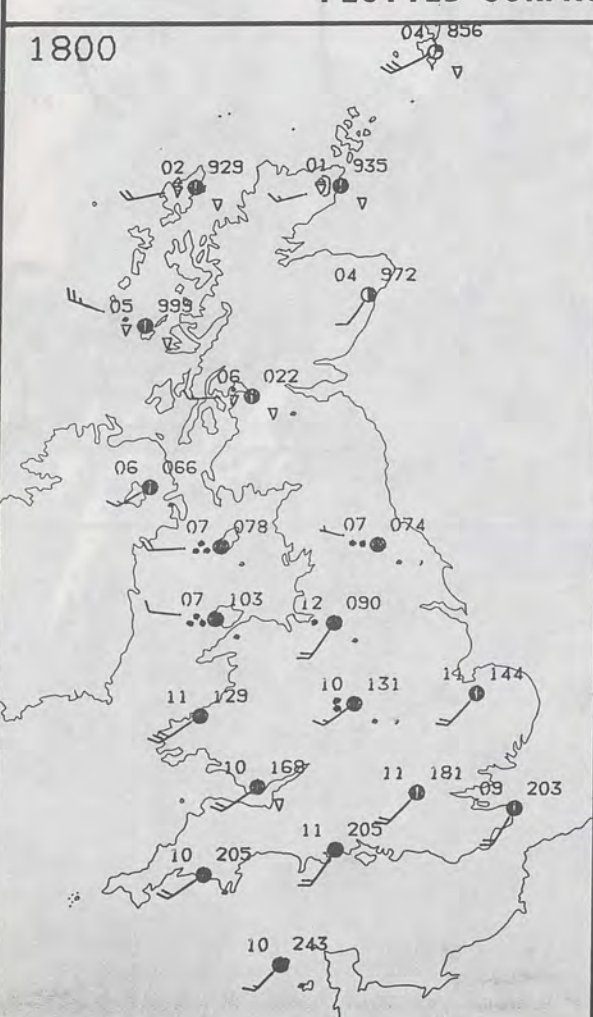
It was a mild or very mild day across much of England and Wales. However temperatures were close to normal in Scotland and Northern Ireland.

Many places in Scotland were clear overnight, but there were showers of rain, hail, sleet or snow, mainly in the north and west and Northern Ireland had showers as well.

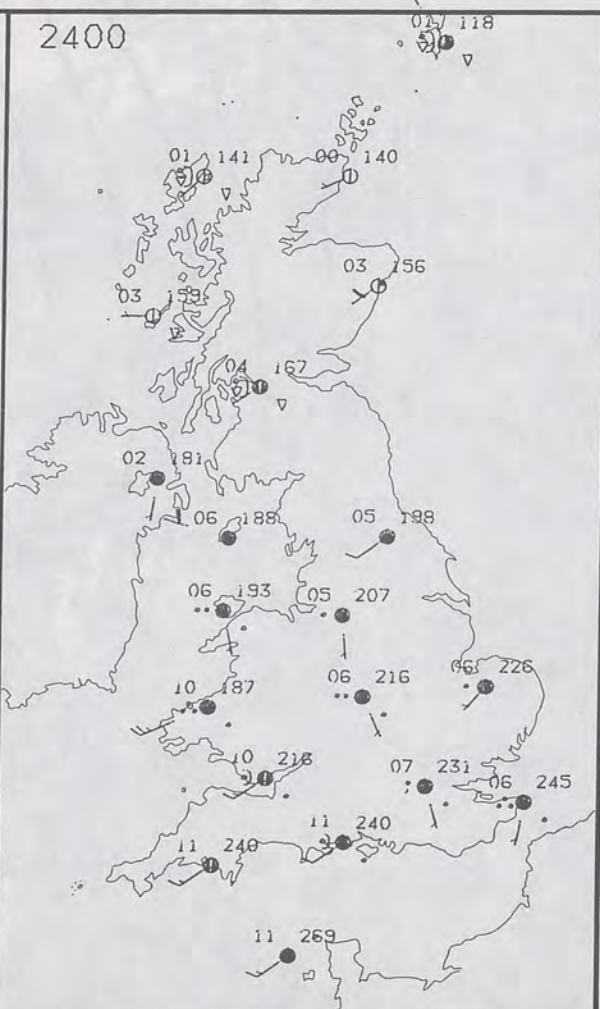
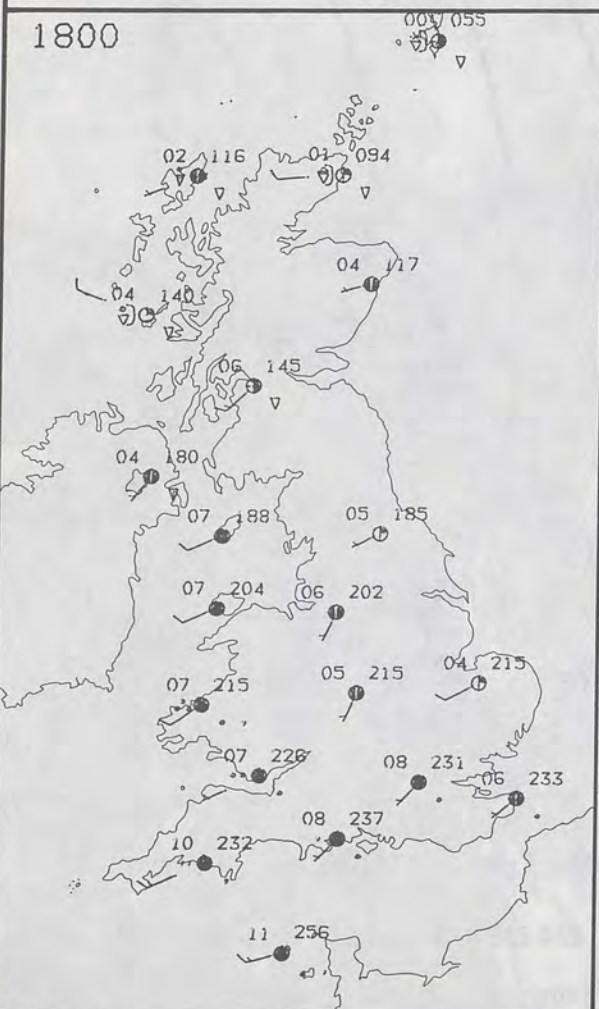
Northern England was mostly dry and clear, although most places in England and Wales had rain for a time, but Wales, the Midlands and East Anglia turned clearer before daybreak.

PLOTTED SURFACE OBSERVATIONS



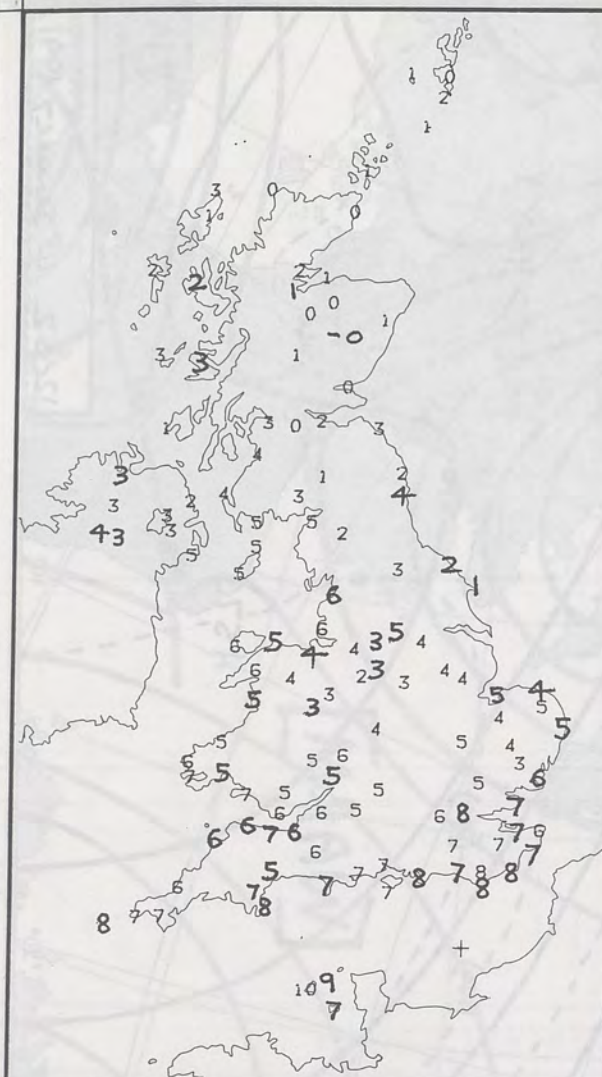
Scotland had some sunshine, but most places had showers, falling as rain, hail, sleet or snow.

Over Scotland and Northern Ireland temperatures were below average, but England and Wales were on the mild side.

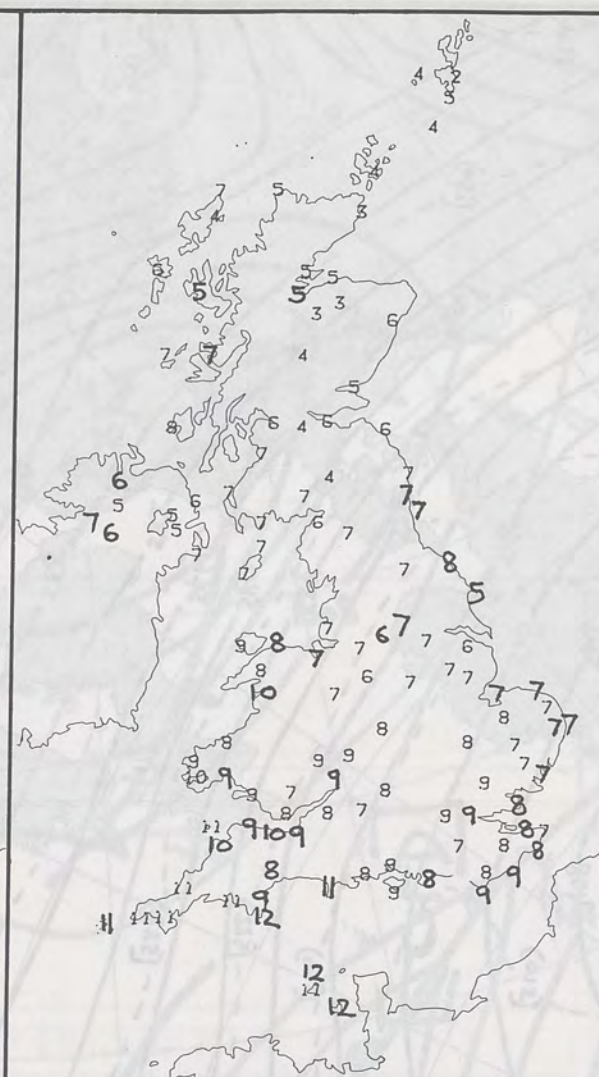

Much of Scotland had a dry, bright day, but there were showers of rain, sleet or snow, mostly in the isles. The south brightened up after a cloudy start.

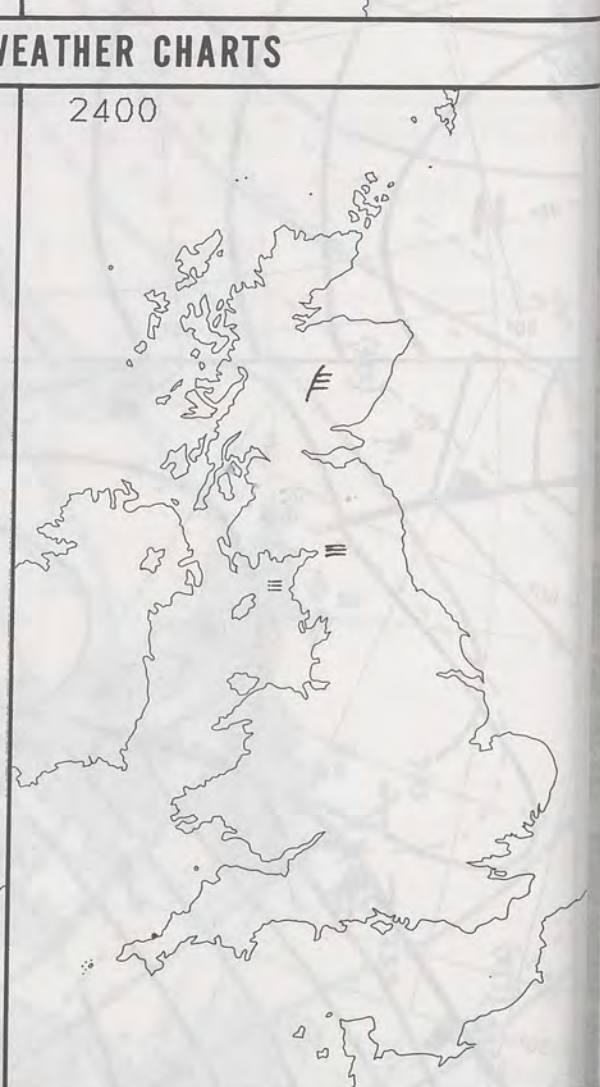
Northern Ireland was cloudy with more rain and drizzle, particularly in the morning.

England and Wales were cloudy too. Southern areas had only a little rain with most places dry, but northern districts had persistent and at times heavy rain.

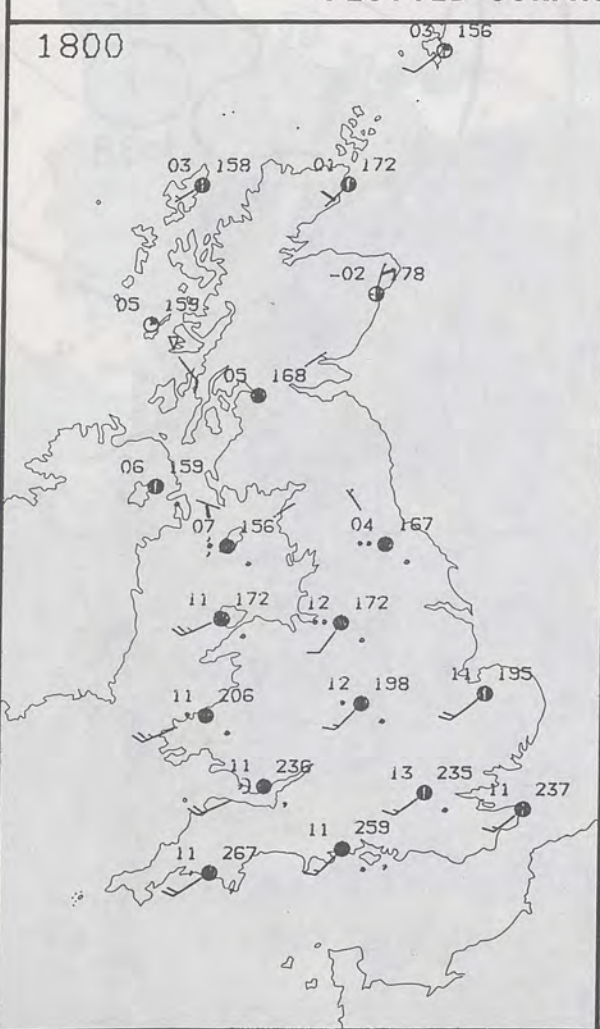
Wales and central and southern England were very mild, but farther north it was a rather cold day.

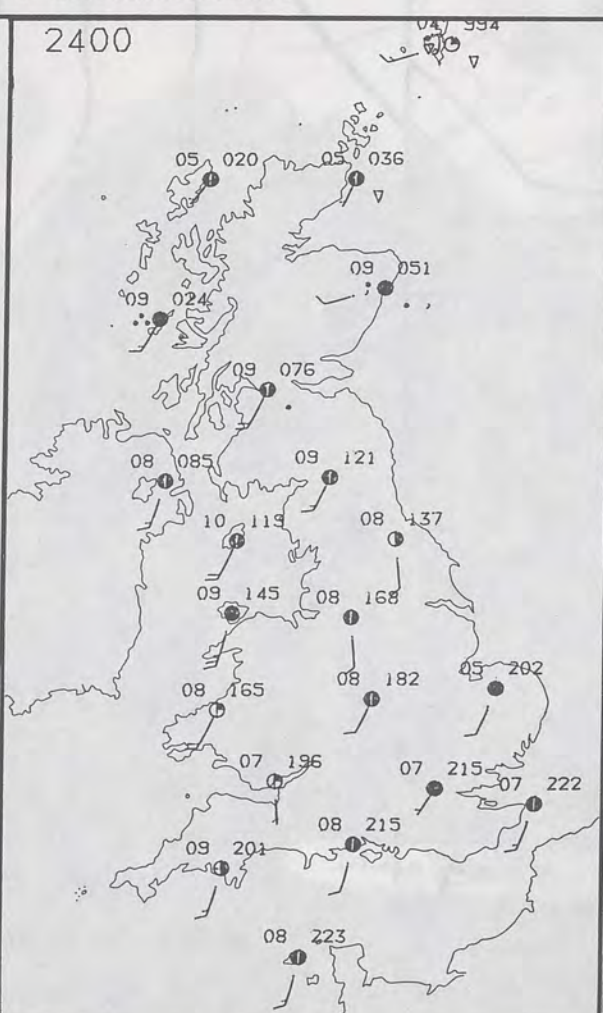
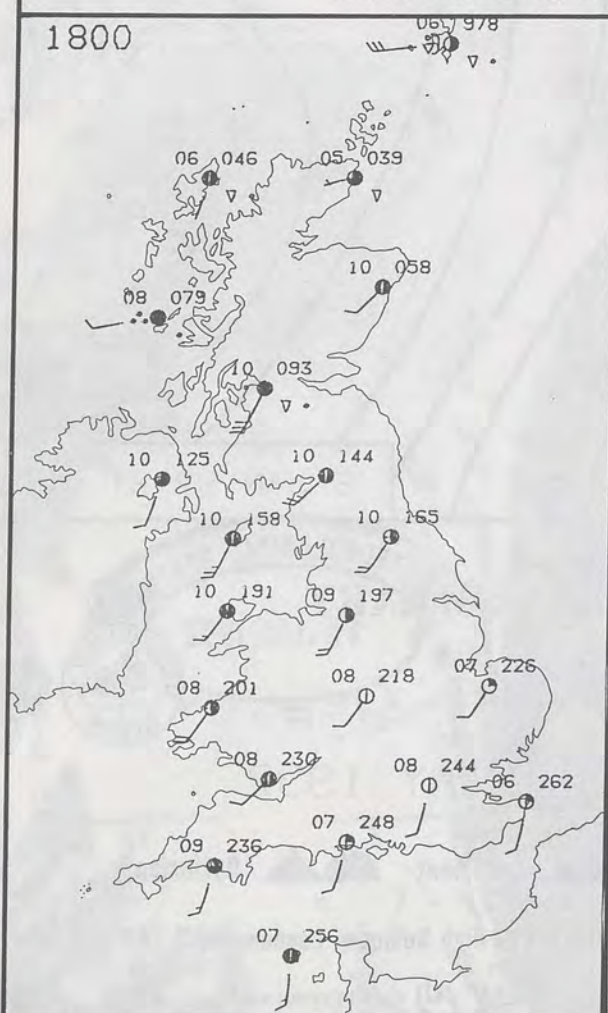
Southern and central Scotland had a wet night with snow on the hills, but in northern England and Northern Ireland the rain died away in the early hours. the far north of Scotland had a few showers overnight but the bulk of Wales and the southern half of England remained dry and rather cloudy. It was a very mild night almost everywhere.

During the day the rain, some of it heavy and persistent moved into northern Scotland for a time, but then later the colder, brighter weather with hail showers moved back southwards. In the meantime southern Scotland became dry and brighter before the rain returned to southwest Scotland in the afternoon.

It was a mild night over the whole of the British Isles however a front spread slowly southeast across Scotland and Northern Ireland bringing outbreaks of rain locally heavy and persistent, and strong to gale force winds in places.

The morning started wet and cloudy over Scotland, Northern Ireland and Cumbria. Wales and the rest of England had a dry morning with some sunny breaks in central and southeastern parts, and just a few showers in some western coastal areas. Over Scotland and Northern Ireland the rain persisted, being heavy and wintry over the high ground. Brighter showery conditions spread into the northern isles and parts of northwest Scotland. There was little change during the afternoon across most of Scotland and Northern Ireland.

England and Wales stayed generally dry with some bright spells, but cloud spread across the southwest with rain into Devon by early evening. This rain spread slowly north into south Wales during the evening. The rest of England and Wales had a cloudy, but dry evening. Scotland and Northern Ireland remained wet with heavy rain in places, with some snow over the highlands. The far north west was clearer with wintry showers.

It was a mild or very mild day over most of England and Wales with temps nearer normal in the far north.

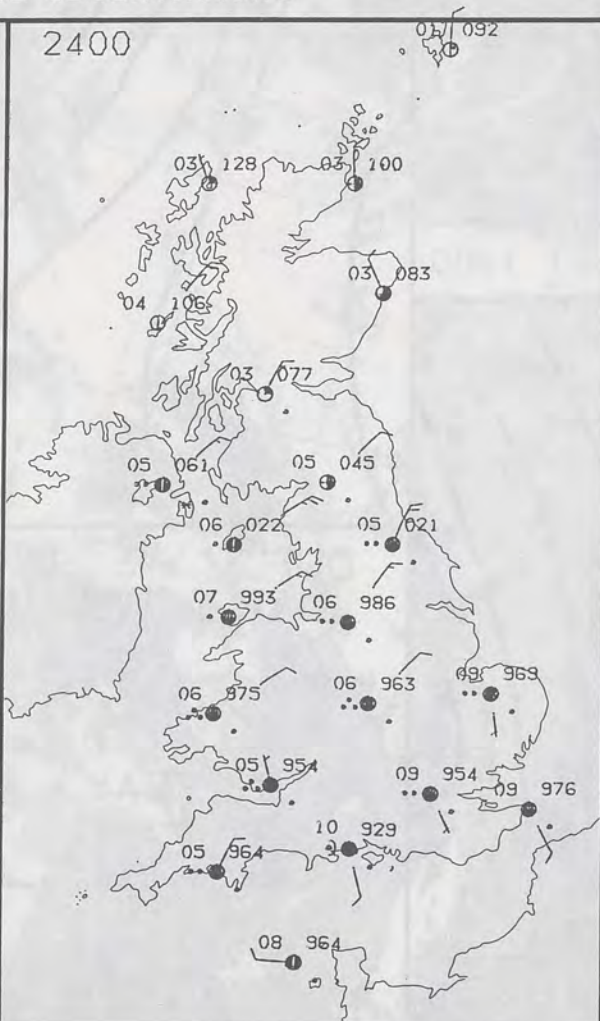
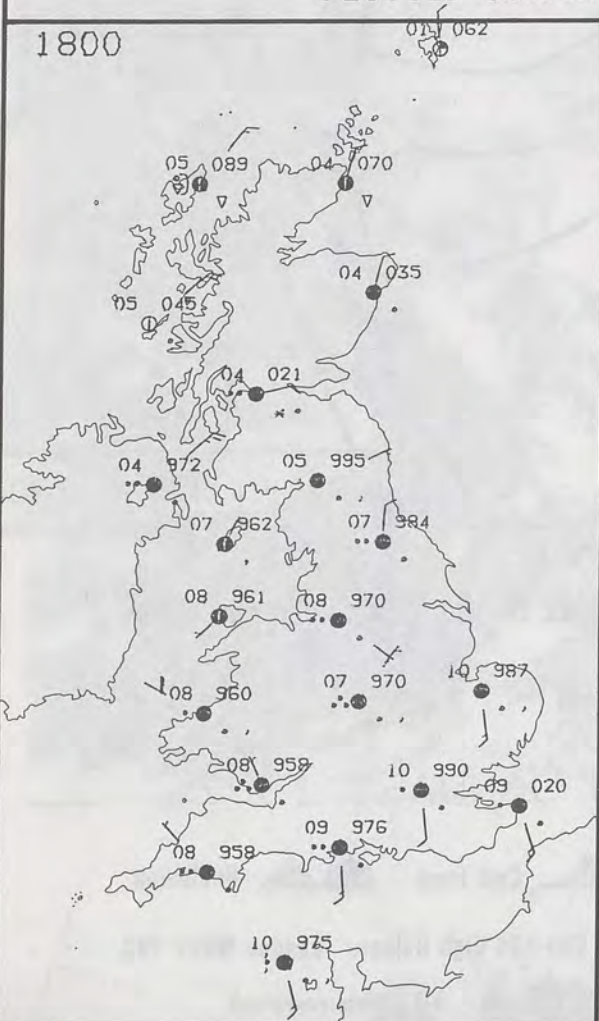
It was a cloudy, wet and windy night across most of the British Isles with mild temperatures and strong winds over southern parts.

Northern parts of England and Wales stayed somewhat drier, but Northern Ireland was cloudy with outbreaks of rain. Southern Scotland had persistent and locally heavy rain with sleet and snow falls in many areas. The far north of Scotland and the Northern Isles were clearer with wintry showers.

During the morning clearer drier conditions spread from the southwest over much of central and northern England bringing a brighter and drier middle to the day. Many southern and southwestern coastal areas however stayed cloudy with outbreaks of rain. Central and southern Scotland had further rain, sleet or snow with the far north and west brighter with wintry showers in many areas.



PLOTTED SURFACE OBSERVATIONS

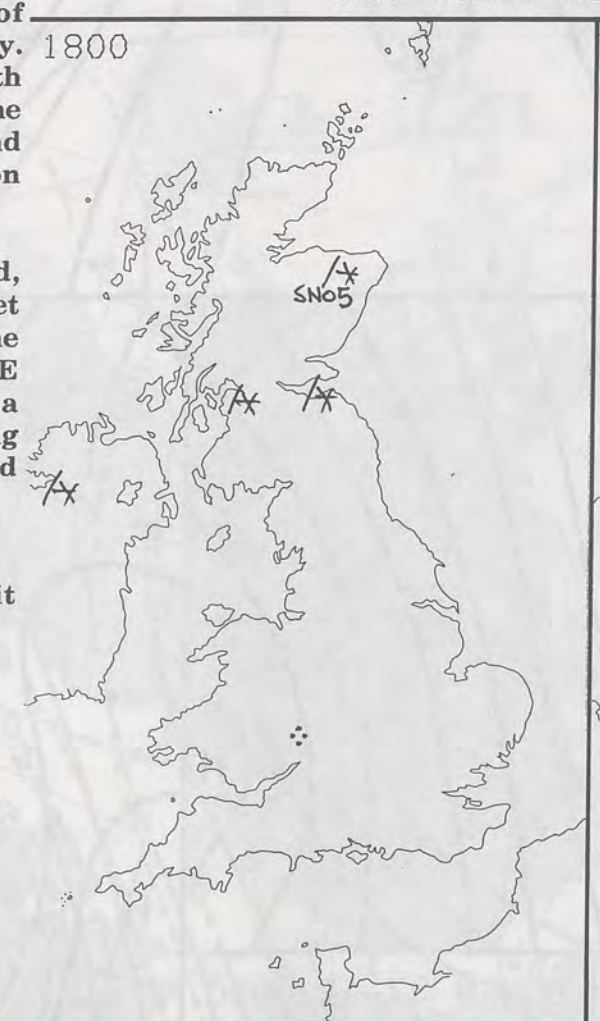


The front spread slowly south during the afternoon with rain across most of northern England by the end of the day. Further rain also spread from the south across all of Wales and England with some heavy outbursts in places. Northern and central Scotland had a cold afternoon with wintry showers.

The evening was wet across England, Wales and Northern Ireland with sleet and snow over the higher ground in the north. The rain in East Anglia and SE England was mainly light. Scotland had a clearer evening with temperatures falling sharply and showers becoming confined to coastal areas and hills.

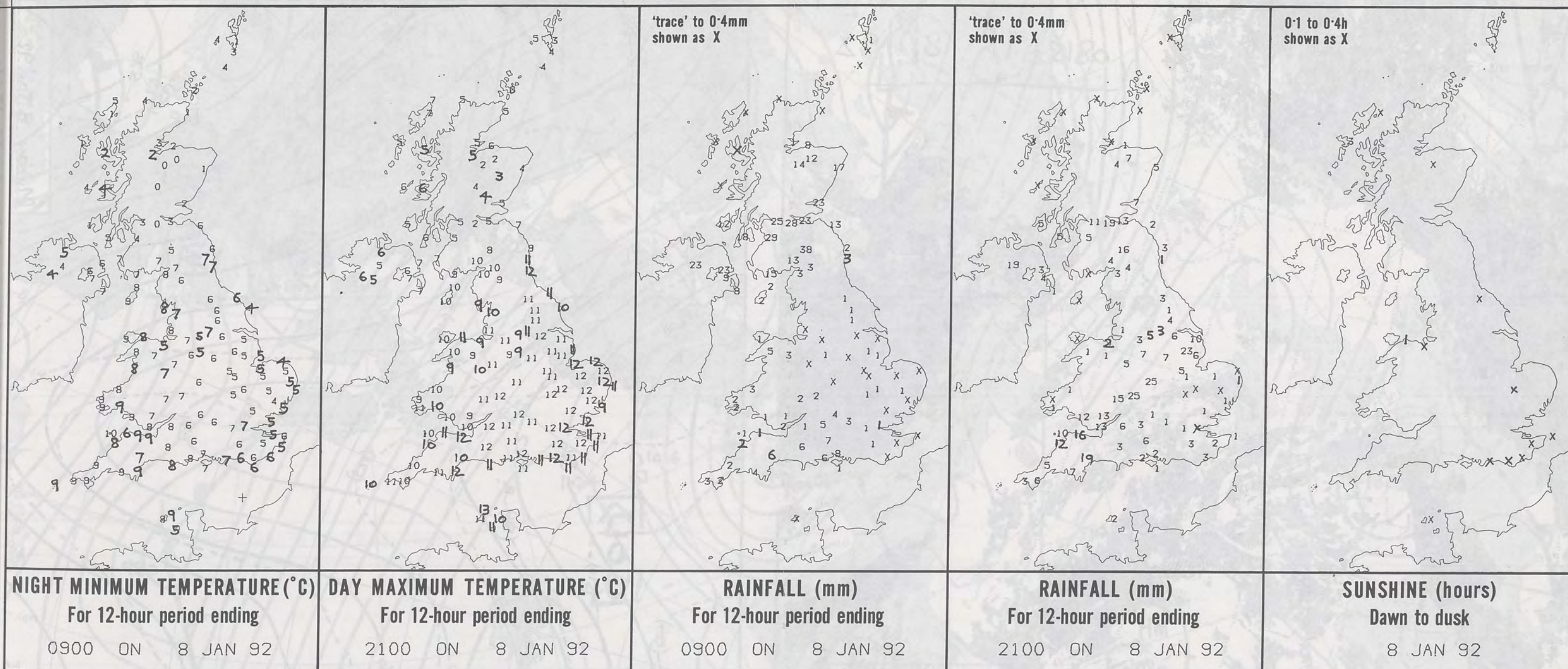
It was a rather cold day in the north elsewhere it was mostly very mild but it became colder later.

SUMMARY OF BRITISH WEATHER

Much of Scotland and Northern Ireland had a dry night with clear periods and a frost in places. Wintry showers occurred in the western and northern isles, and along mainland coasts exposed to the northerly winds. England and Wales had mainly cloudy skies with heavy rain at times, with sleet or snow over the higher hills. However some southern and SE parts of England remained dry for much of the night with clear intervals and mild. Clear periods already into parts of northern England, spread slowly south into north Wales by the end of the night but showers affected some NE coasts.

By day many parts of Scotland, Northern Ireland, northern England and north Wales had a dry day with sunny periods, although a few wintry showers occurred, especially on north facing coasts. Other parts of England and Wales had a mostly cloudy day with rain, heavy at times especially over the Midlands and central Wales, where sleet and wet snow occurred mainly over hills, but not exclusively so.

Towards evening central southern and SE England had a little sleet or snow over the hills, but by this time clear periods had developed over much of the remainder of England and Wales with just a few wintry showers.

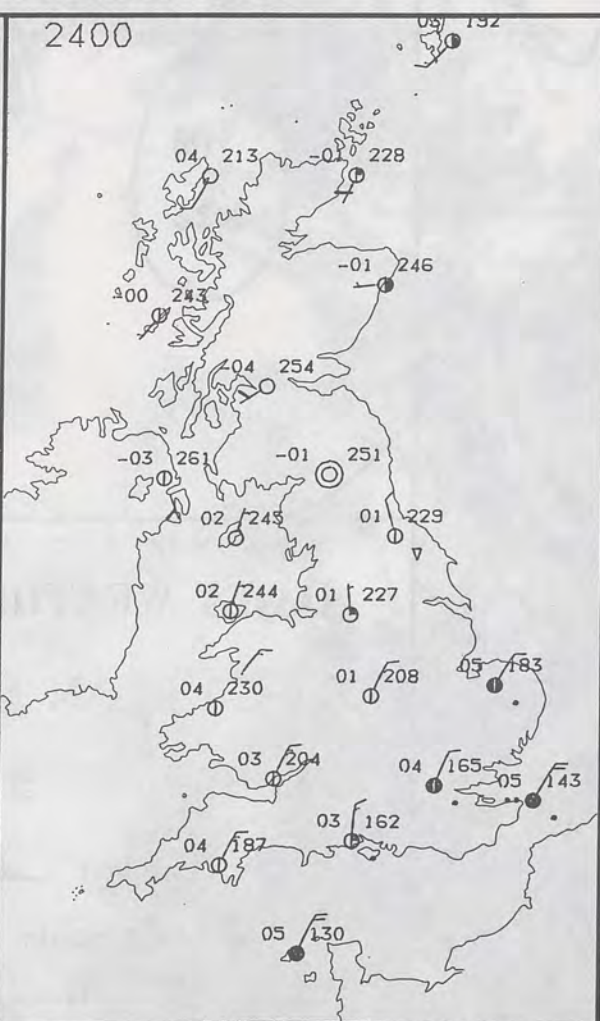
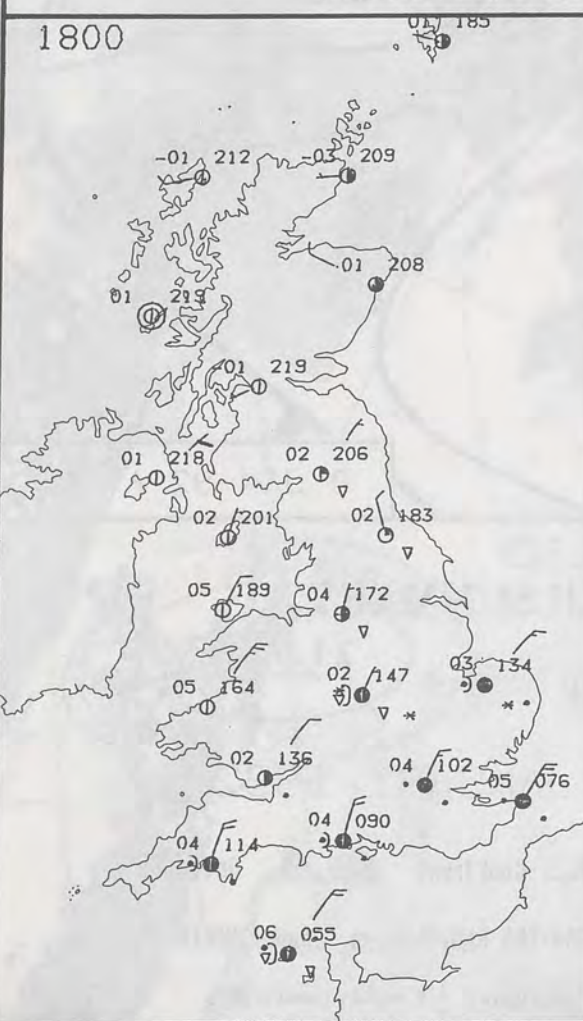
After a mild start to the day in SE England, most of the United Kingdom had a rather cold day, accentuated in southern Britain by a fresh or strong NE wind.

Scotland had a lot of cloud during the day, but most places were dry, although there was a little rain and drizzle in the west and north, mainly in the islands.

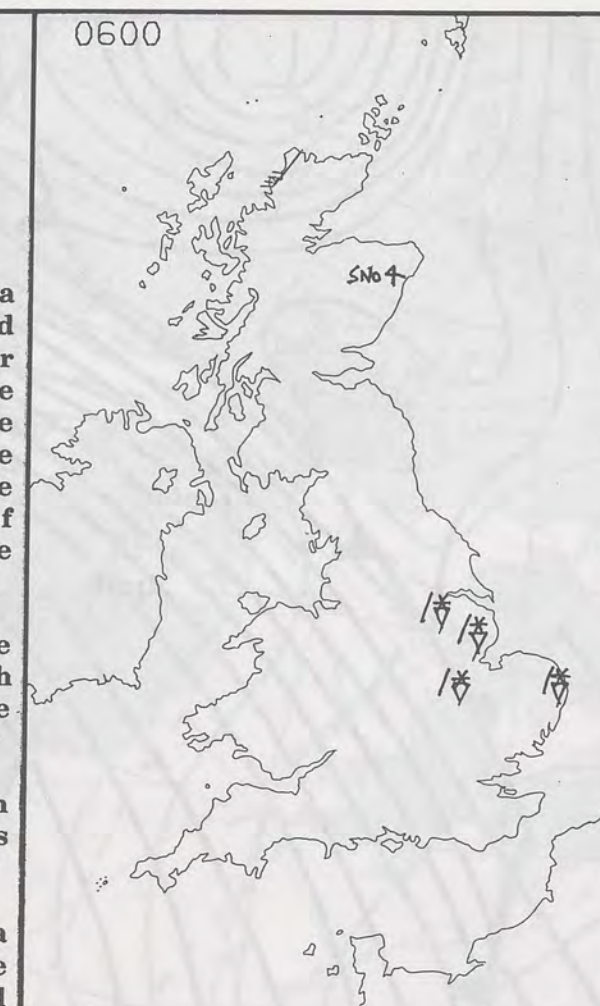
After a sunny morning Northern Ireland turned cloudy and there was a little rain and drizzle in the evening.

Wales and much of England had a sunny day, but over England there were a few showers or rain, sleet and snow scattered about.

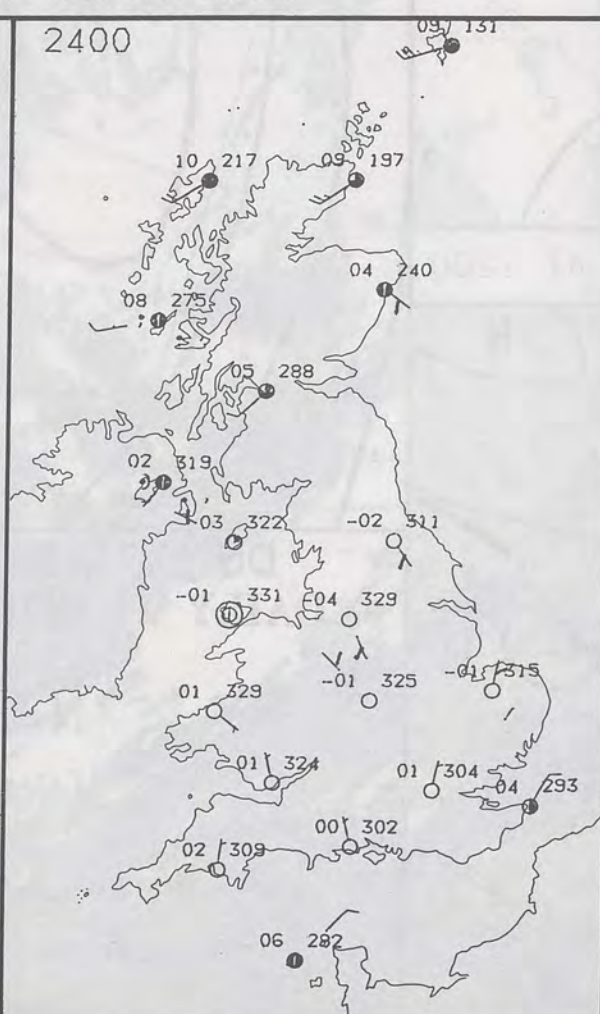
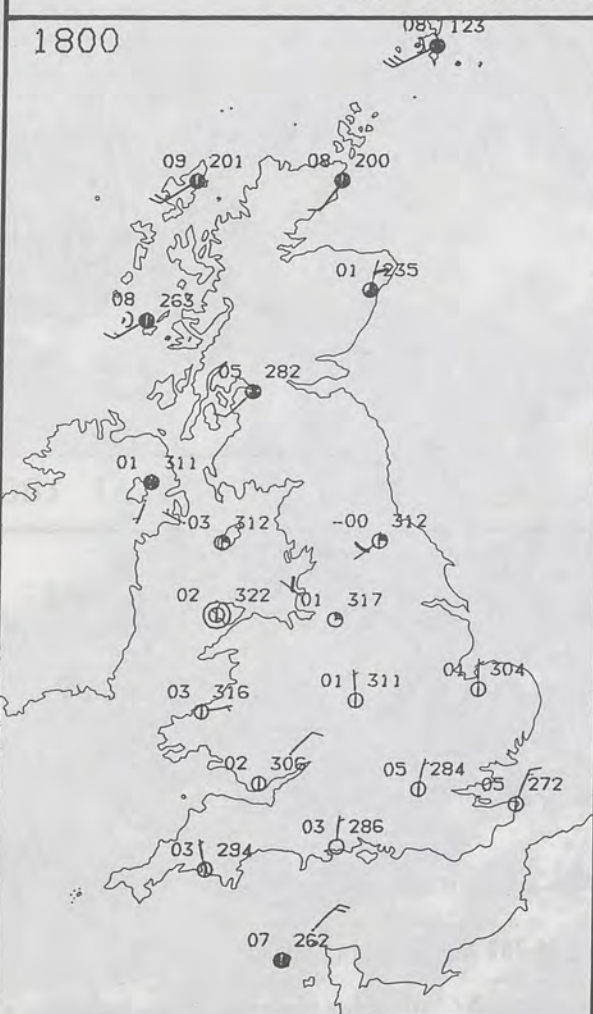

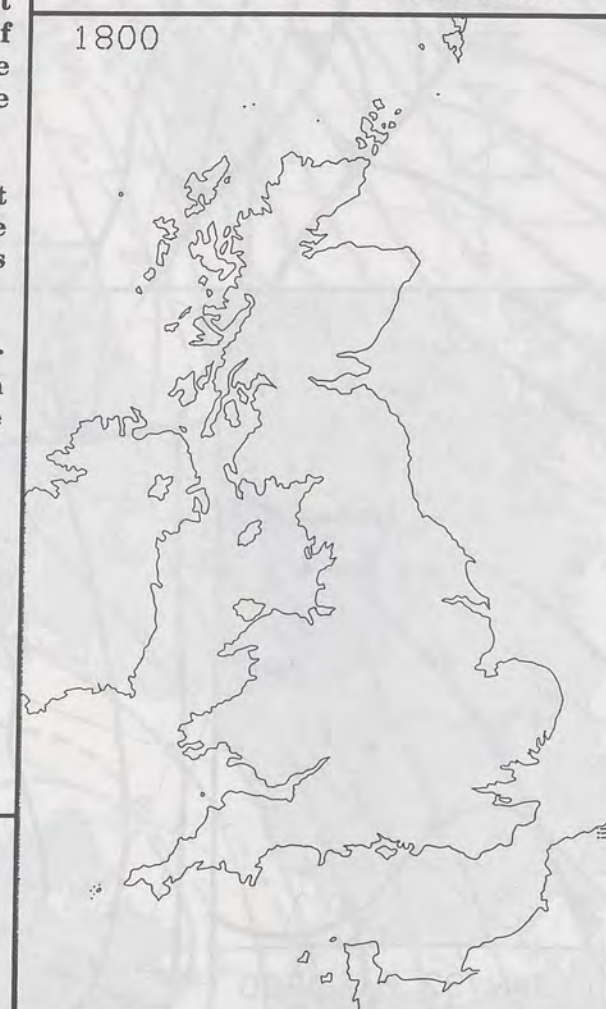
South Wales had a sunny morning, but the north turned cloudy and much of Wales clouded over during the afternoon and early evening and in the north there was drizzle.

Northern Ireland and northern Scotland had a rather cloudy and relatively mild night with drizzle on some of the coasts and hills. Elsewhere the night was also rather cloudy but breaks in the cloud allowed a frost with fairly widespread mist and fog. The fog was dense in parts of the south and east of England and was freezing in places.

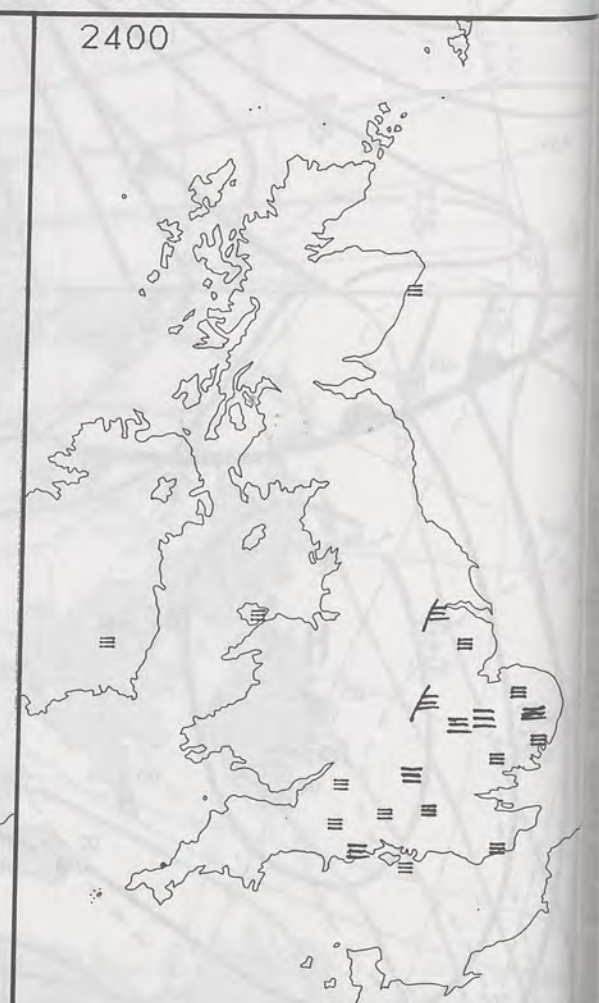
Northern Ireland and northern Scotland had a mild day but in most places temperatures were near average and where the fog hung on it was rather cold or cold.

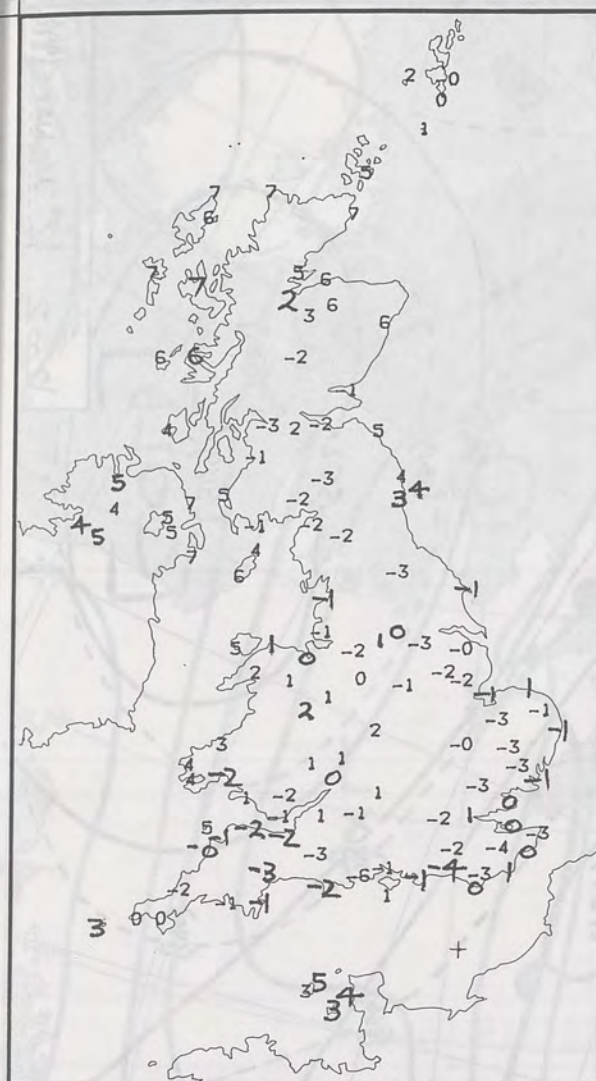

Overnight most of the country was cloudy with a weak frontal zone crossing eastern and southern counties of England and bringing patchy light rain or drizzle. Temperatures were near normal in many areas but were mild in eastern Scotland and rather cold where the mists/ fog persisted in eastern parts of England.

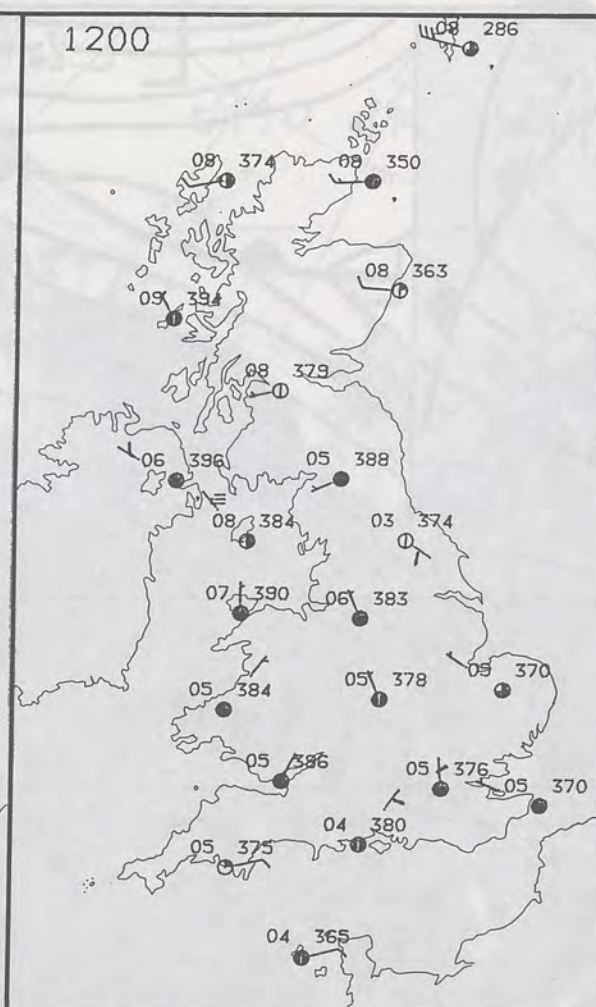

Overnight most places stayed dry with a widespread frost and freezing fog patches forming particularly over Northern Ireland, Southern Scotland, Wales, Northwestern and central areas of England, East Anglia and parts of the Southeast. Elsewhere it was dry and mostly frost free.

During the morning thicker cloud brought some patchy outbreaks of light drizzle over the Northern and Western Islands and coasts of Scotland. Elsewhere it stayed dry with Southern Counties of England rather cloudy and the mist and fog slowly clearing in most areas.

During the afternoon a few spots of drizzle affected the coasts of South East England, whilst outbreaks also continued over North and Western parts of Scotland. Much of the rest of the British Isles had a sunny afternoon but the fog and mist did linger in many places.

During the evening mist and fog readily reformed across much of England, Northern Ireland and Wales with visibilities down to 80 yards or less in places well before midnight. A few spots of drizzle continued over coastal fringes of the Southeast whilst the far North and West of Northern Ireland and Scotland had further outbreaks of mainly light drizzle.

Overall temperatures were near or slightly above normal over much of Scotland but elsewhere it was mainly rather cold and cold where the fog lingered.

Northern and western parts of Scotland were generally rather cloudy overnight with some outbreaks of drizzle in places. Further south and east, it remained dry with well broken cloud, allowing a frost to develop and some patchy fog.

Northern Ireland, apart from some light drizzle in the north of the province, had a dry and foggy night, although cloud later in the night helped to clear the fog. Far northern and western parts of Scotland had a mild and generally cloudy night with a little drizzle in places.
