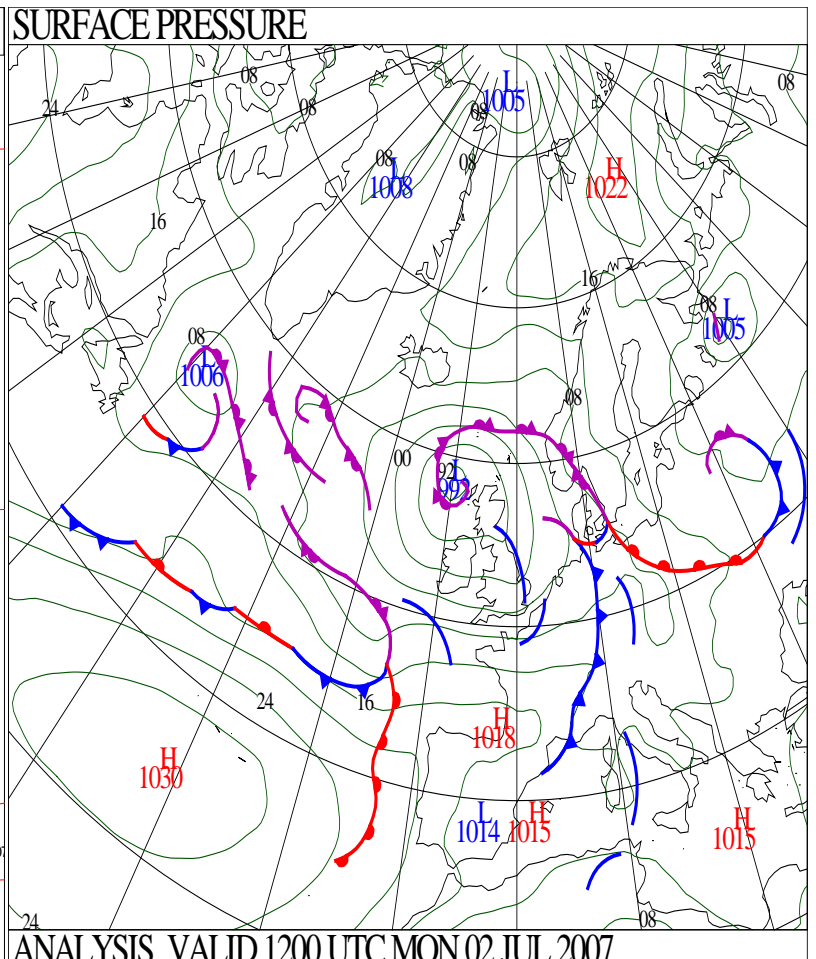
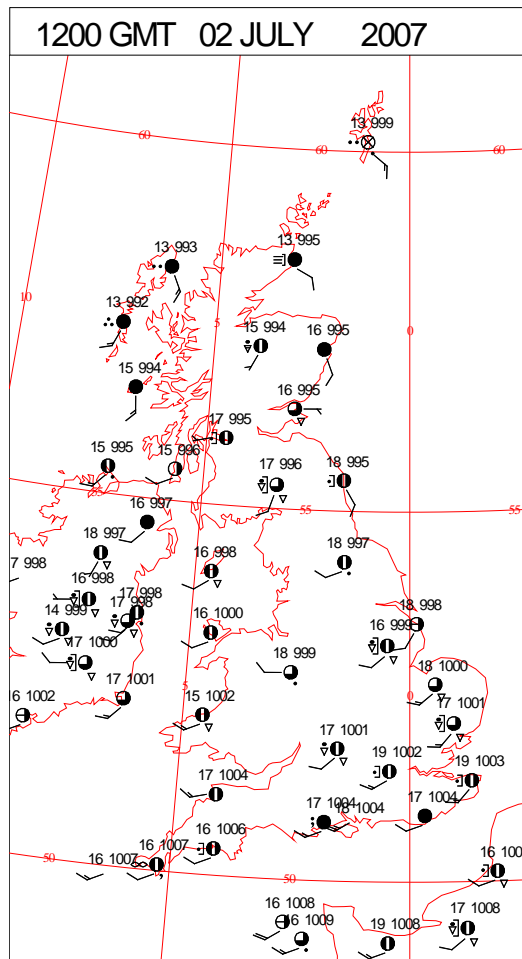
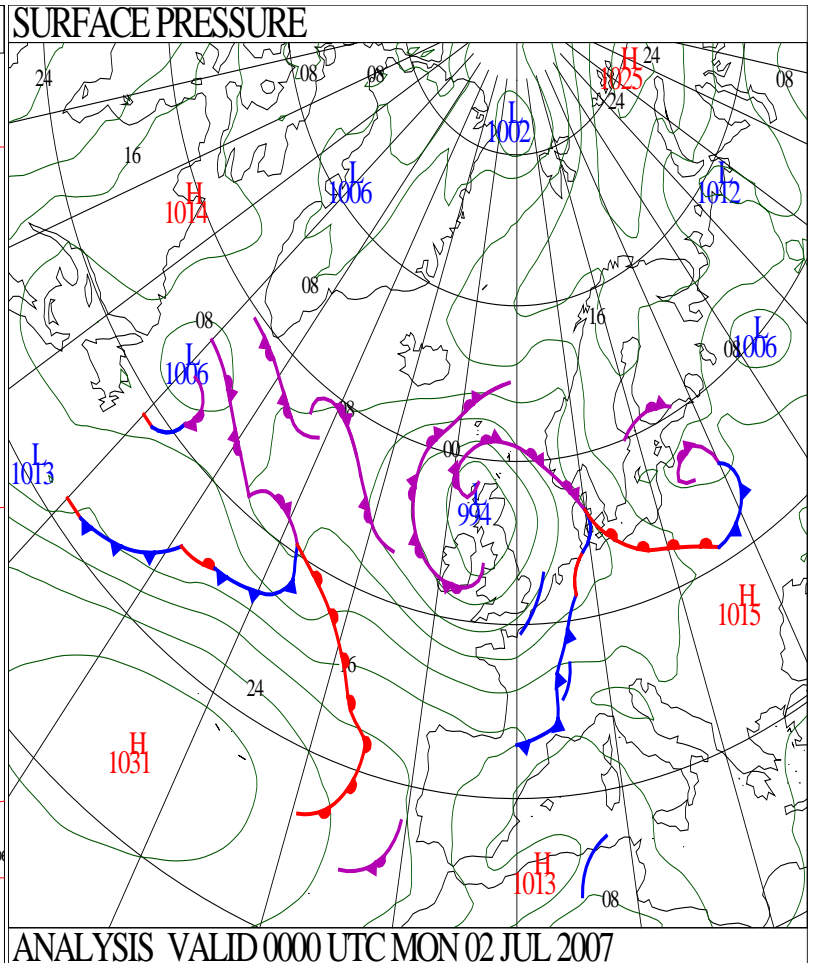
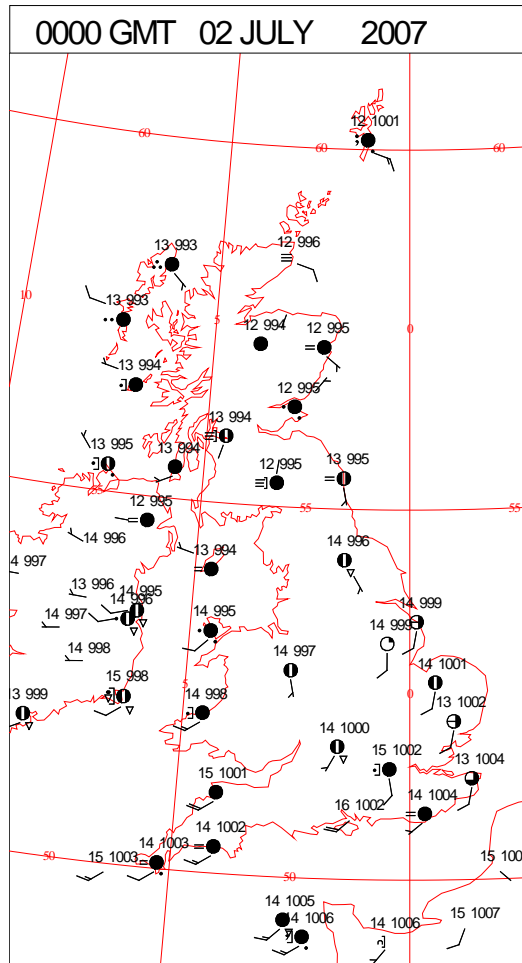
| 0600 GMT 01 JULY 2007 | SIG WEATHER | 1200 GMT 01 JULY 2007 | SIG WEATHER | <p><b>Summary of UK Weather for Sunday 01 July 2007.</b></p> <p>The day started on a rather wet note for many with several bands of rain spreading quickly northeastwards through the early hours of the morning. With low pressure centred across the Isle of Man there was nowhere to escape the rain as the vast majority of Northern Ireland, Scotland, England and Wales received a peppering of showers throughout the morning.</p> <p>The showers soon merged to give longer spells of rain across Wales, northern England and Scotland with a further 27mm in eight hours being received across parts of the Pennines. By contrast however, further south, the showers became more organised through the day and developed along a line from Plymouth to The Wash. This gave the southeast of England shelter from the showers, and the afternoon was dry here with plenty of sunshine.</p> <p>With southwesterly winds and some sunshine across southeastern parts of the UK, the temperatures rose to around the average value for this time of year. By contrast though, with east-southeasterly winds across the cloudier, wetter northern areas, the temperatures struggled and were well below average for the time of year.</p> |

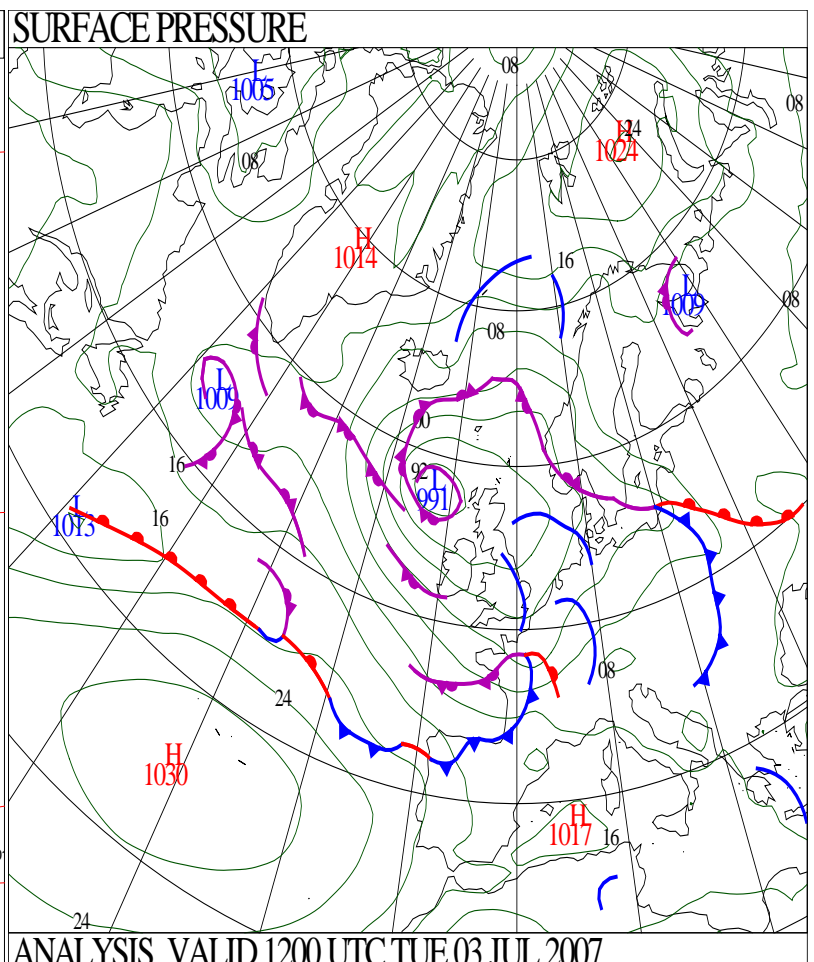
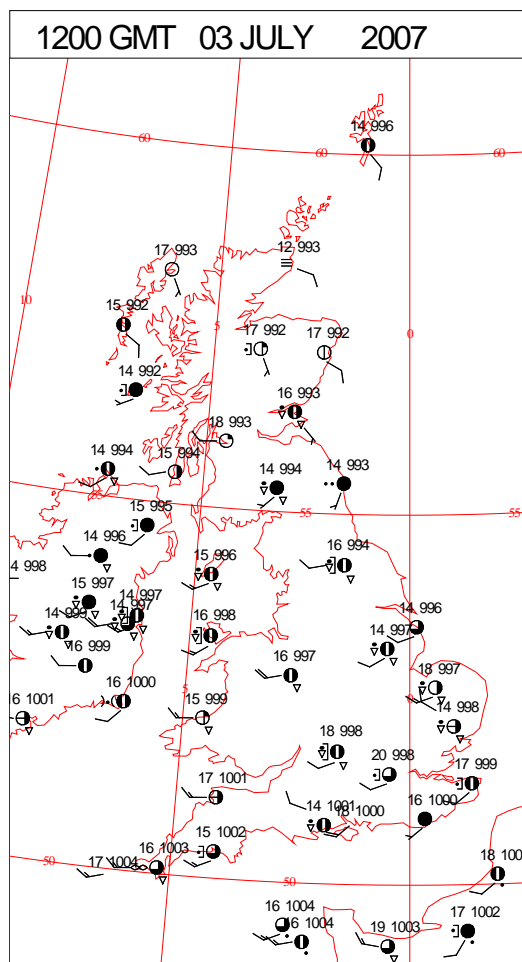
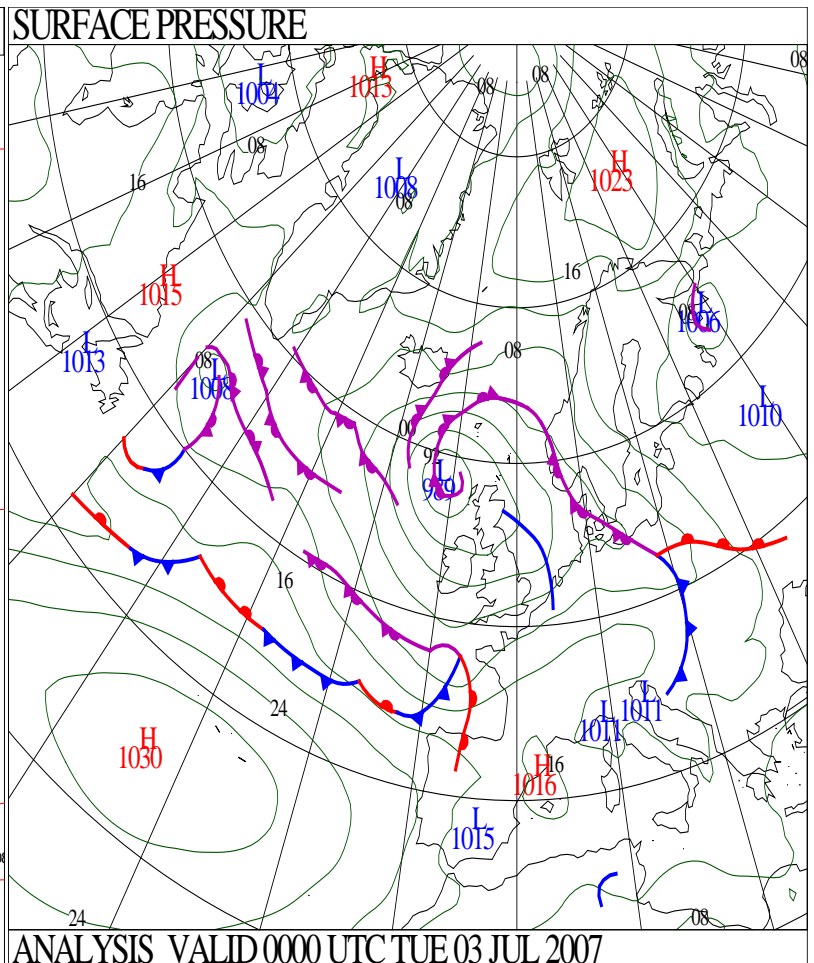
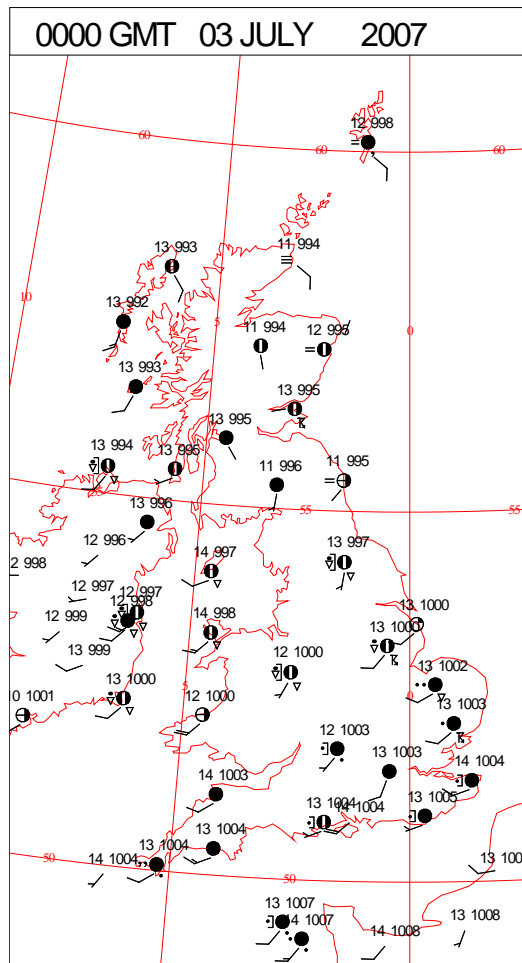
| 0600 GMT 02 JULY 2007 | SIG WEATHER | 1200 GMT 02 JULY 2007 | SIG WEATHER | <p><b>Summary of UK Weather for Monday 02 July 2007.</b></p> <p>The very unsettled conditions continued across the UK as low pressure remained to the west of Scotland.</p> <p>The far northwest of Scotland, in particular the Western Isles, saw outbreaks of rain during the morning, but Wales bore the brunt of the heavy showers during the early hours, with some torrential downpours. The rest of the UK saw a mixture of very occasional sunny spells and plenty of showers, which became most intense across eastern parts of England and Scotland during daylight hours, notably giving numerous interruptions at Wimbledon.</p> <p>Lightning was observed quite widely during the afternoon, and spot rainfall totals exceeded 10mm per hour at a number of stations across central and eastern England. Northern Ireland had a relatively dry start but areas of heavy showers moved northeast during the afternoon. Similarly, an area of persistent rain moved rapidly eastwards during the evening, across southern England, eventually clearing into the North Sea by midnight.</p> <p>It was a blustery day with the strongest of the winds across Wales and southern England, with gusts in excess of 30 m.p.h. at times. Temperatures were generally around average or below, adding to the unseasonable feel to the weather.</p> |

| 0600 GMT 03 JULY 2007 | SIG WEATHER | 1200 GMT 03 JULY 2007 | SIG WEATHER | <p><b>Summary of UK Weather for Tuesday 03 July 2007.</b></p> <p>Heavy, blustery showers continued to blow in from the west during the early hours, becoming increasingly active and widespread during daylight hours. There were some torrential downpours, with hail and thunder for many places, with very few escaping the showers completely. 'Flash' messages were issued late in the afternoon after lines of intense precipitation formed across southern England in particular. Some sunshine showed through at times, but the majority of the UK remained under a good deal of cloud. The showers tended to ease and become less widespread again during the evening, the heaviest persisted across East Anglia and the South East until late evening, but further showers persisted elsewhere right the way through. A brisk westerly breeze covered much of the UK, and became gusty in and around showers. Temperatures were once again widely below average for the time of year.</p> |

| 0600 GMT 04 JULY 2007 | SIG WEATHER | 1200 GMT 04 JULY 2007 | SIG WEATHER | <p><b>Summary of UK Weather for Wednesday 04 July 2007.</b></p> <p>The unsettled theme continued as rain and showers affected most parts across the UK. By dawn an occlusion had moved southeastwards into Northern Ireland bringing widespread showers. Overnight rain over northeast Scotland led to the issue of 'Flash' messages for Aberdeenshire. Heavy, blustery showers continued throughout the night, becoming increasingly active and widespread during daylight hours. There were some torrential thundery downpours, with very few places escaping the showers completely. Some sunshine showed through at times, but the majority of the UK remained under a good deal of cloud. 'Flash' messages were issued for central and eastern Scotland along with the north Midlands and Lincolnshire for the afternoon and evening. The showers tended to ease and become less widespread during the evening in most western parts except Wales. In Wales and Central and Eastern England the showers continued later into the evening. A brisk westerly breeze covered much of the UK, and became gusty in and around showers. It was generally a rather mild night however daytime temperatures were once again widely below average for the time of year.</p> |

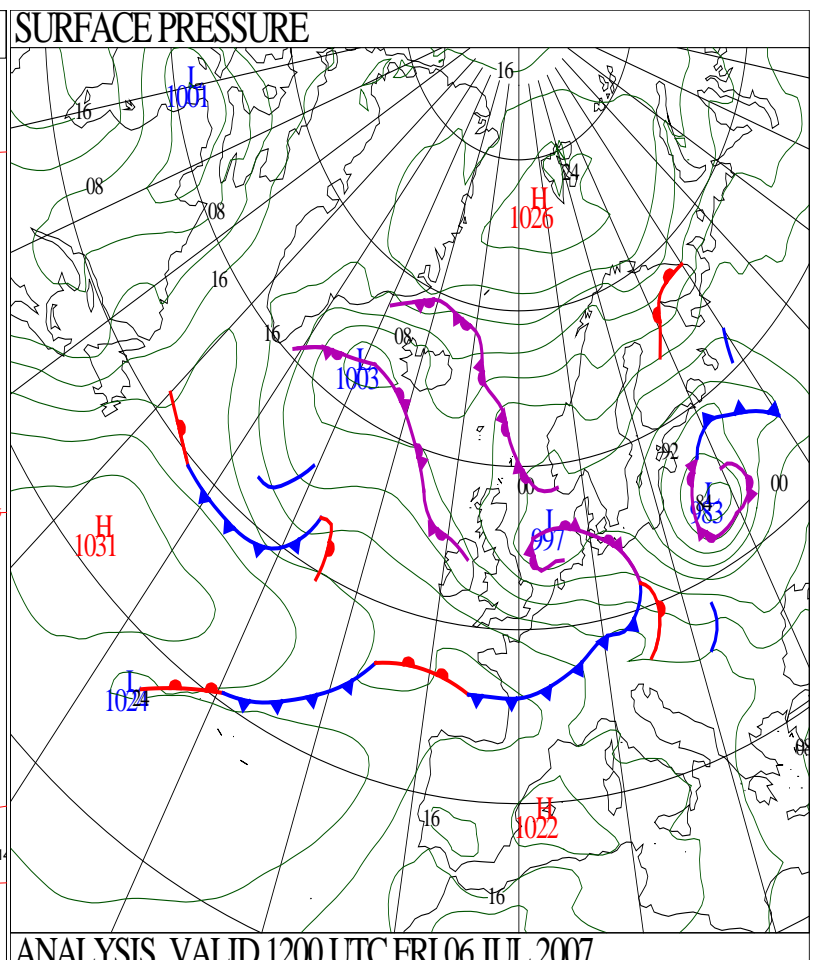
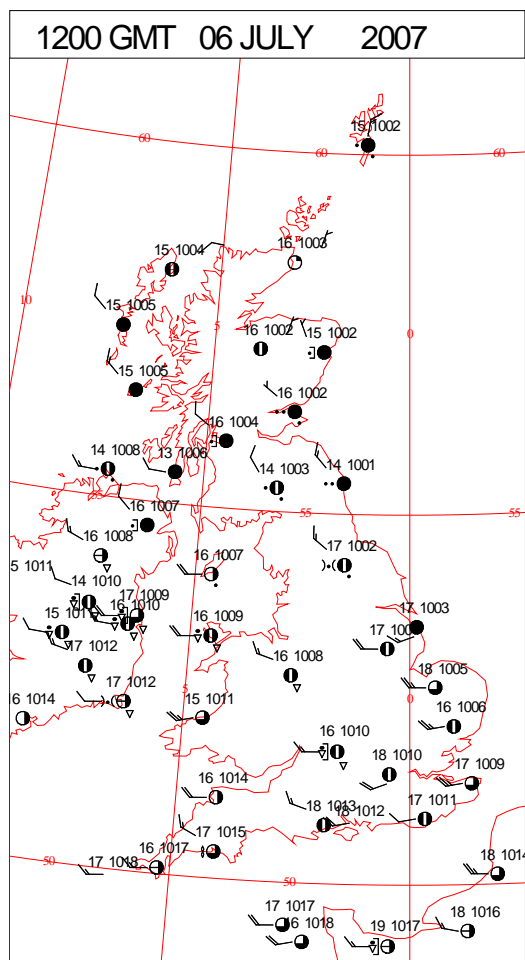
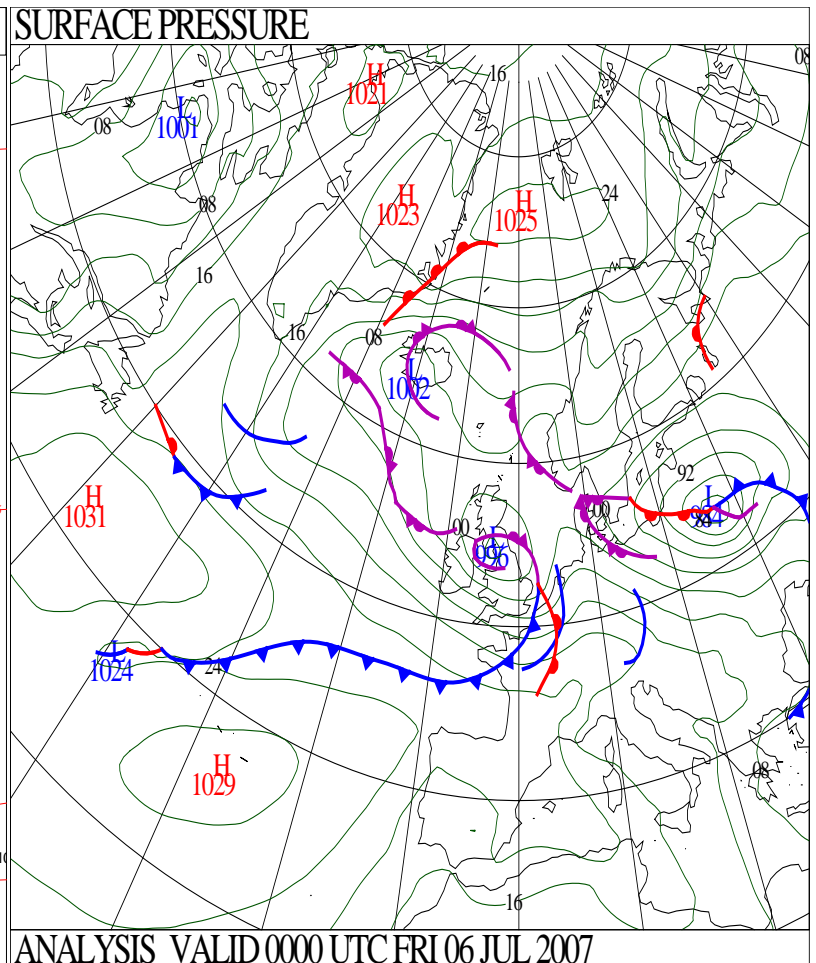
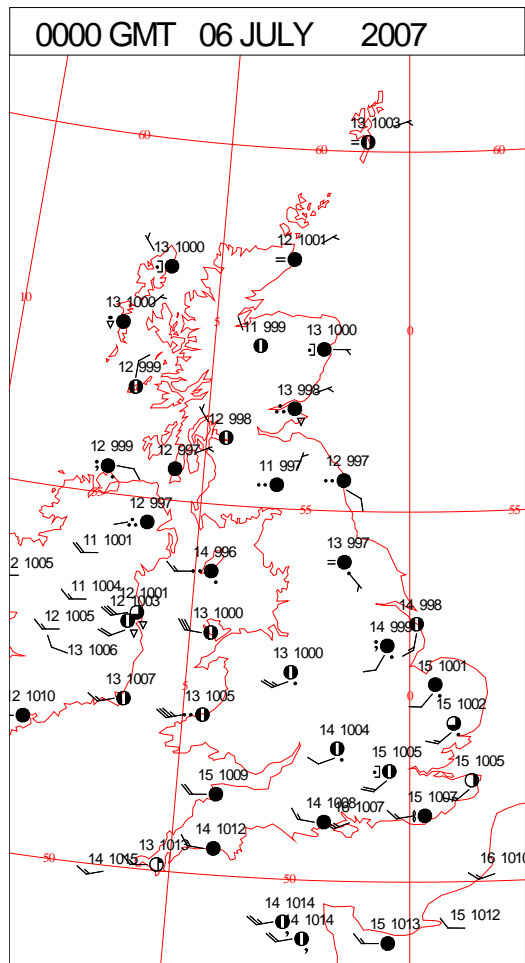
| 0600 GMT 05 JULY 2007 | SIG WEATHER | 1200 GMT 05 JULY 2007 | SIG WEATHER | <p><b>Summary of UK Weather for Thursday 05 July 2007.</b></p> <p>The unsettled theme continued as rain and showers affected most parts across the UK through the course of the day. Many places had a dry, rather cloudy night, but there were still some showers in places, notably in the north and parts of the west. During the day, there was a little sunshine in some places, but scattered showers developed and some of these were heavy across northeast Scotland. A weather system and its associated rain band moved into Cornwall soon after dawn, spreading east-northeastwards across Northern Ireland, Wales and much of England during the day. The majority of this rainfall was light and persistent at times with some heavier bursts. A brisk-to-strong southwesterly wind affected much of the south of the UK, in particular along exposed coasts of western England. It was generally a rather mild night; however, daytime temperatures were once again widely below average for the time of year.</p> |

| 0600 GMT 06 JULY 2007 | SIG WEATHER | 1200 GMT 06 JULY 2007 | SIG WEATHER | <p><b>Summary of UK Weather for Friday 06 July 2007.</b></p> <p>Rain and showers continued across northern parts of the UK during the early hours, particularly northern England, Scotland and Northern Ireland, whilst more southern areas became dry although still keeping a good deal of cloud. It was windy across the south too. Rain and showers then continued across northern areas during the day with some locally heavy bursts in places as well as some thunderstorms across the far northeast of England and parts of Scotland. Showers also affected the Midlands whilst the south of the UK enjoyed a dry day with some good spells of sunshine. However, it remained windy across the south with strong gusts in places. Showers slowly started to ease and die away during the evening, although lingering across northeast England and east Scotland in particular. | 0600 GMT 07 JULY 2007 | SIG WEATHER | 1200 GMT 07 JULY 2007 | SIG WEATHER | <p><b>Summary of UK Weather for Saturday 07 July 2007.</b></p> <p>A few scattered showers continued during the early hours across Northern Ireland, some parts of northern England and western Scotland, whilst the far northeast of Scotland saw persistent rain. Elsewhere it was essentially dry with clear spells during the early hours. During the morning further showers started to develop across northern England and Northern Ireland and Scotland, the odd heavy one starting to break out and continuing through the afternoon with a few thunderstorms in the northeast. There was the odd shower across East Anglia for a time during the afternoon too. However, much of central and southern England and Wales saw a dry day with good spells of sunshine and lighter winds compared to yesterday. More persistent rain continued over northeast Scotland but also spread further southwestwards into other parts of the country through the day. Showers died away into the evening with many areas becoming dry with sunshine to end the day, although rain continued across Scotland through the evening. | 0600 GMT 08 JULY 2007 | SIG WEATHER | 1200 GMT 08 JULY 2007 | SIG WEATHER | <p><b>Summary of UK Weather for Sunday 08 July 2007.</b></p> <p>Rain persisted in northern Scotland during the early hours, but most other places were dry with clear skies until around dawn. A few mist and fog patches formed in the southwest. Showers began to break out over western Scotland and north Wales. The showers became thundery at times and extended across much of northern England, though Cumbria and Northumberland stayed mostly dry. Hourly rainfall totals in excess of 10mm occurred at several stations in north Wales and northwest England e.g. Hawarden 15.2mm 1100–1200 UTC, Bolton 17.4mm 1200–1300 UTCZ. Further showers spread in from the west, affecting the Westcountry and then west Wales and Northern Ireland by midday. The showers were heavy and often thundery, as well as slow-moving due to just a light breeze. East Anglia and the South East though, stayed dry right through the day with good spells of sunshine, although other places saw some brighter spells in between showers. Temperatures were generally close to or just below average for the time of year.</p> |

Flash-flooding was reported in, for example, Weston-Super-Mare, Tenbury Wells and near Grantown-on-Spey. Many more locations across the UK reported precipitation totals that exceeded 10 mm in one hour from heavy rain or hail. Thunderstorms developed in many (mostly inland) locations throughout the day. Four simultaneous funnel clouds were reported at Manchester Airport during the early afternoon, and the updraught from a tornado in Gloucestershire was apparently sufficiently intense to lift a rubbish skip over a house. The evening saw the heaviest showers dying out slowly, but thunderstorms persisted for some time over central and eastern Scotland. A band of rain pushed down from the Northern Isles towards mainland Scotland later in the day. Further rain also began to affect westernmost areas of Northern Ireland as the day ended. Temperatures were generally a little below normal for mid-July.</p> |

The showers developed rapidly during the morning across northern England and southern Scotland with locally torrential downpours and hail observed, giving over 14mm in one hour at Eskdalemuir. Flash-flooding was reported in Filey in North Yorkshire during the afternoon. Downpours and thunderstorms also developed through the Midlands and East Anglia. Across the South East the showers were more isolated, although 17.6mm was recorded in one hour at Kenley. Across southwest England and Wales, there were fewer showers than recently and some decent spells of sunshine, although a convergence zone developed along the south coast giving a few showers during the evening from Cornwall to Dorset. The showers across Northern Ireland took their time to get going, but numerous downpours and thunderstorms were observed during the afternoon, with nearly 14mm in one hour at Glenganne during the evening. The far north of Scotland saw generally cloudy skies and patches of drizzle, and were thus was rather cool for mid July. The rest of the UK saw temperatures generally around average, although the South East was quite warm.</p> |

Patchy overnight rain over Northern Ireland and southern Scotland became more widespread and heavier and, although the afternoon was brighter, further heavy showers and thunderstorms developed. (The semi-automated weather observing system at Belfast was rendered inoperative due to a lightning strike.)</p> <p>Morning sunshine over Pembrokeshire and Cornwall soon began to set off thunderstorms and these merged into more prolonged, heavy showers in the afternoon linked to sea-breeze convergence zones. Elsewhere after a mainly sunny morning, thunderstorms broke out across Lincolnshire, East Anglia and Cumbria. High rainfall totals were reported; Chivenor, for example, reporting 15.8mm in one hour while 22.8mm was reported at Osbournby in Lincolnshire.</p> <p>Temperatures ranged from a warm 23 °C in the south to a chilly 13 °C across central and northern Scotland under cloudy skies. A rather chilly, bleak day for golf spectators at Carnoustie with drizzle and overcast skies.</p> <p>During the evening, increasingly unstable air set off showers across south Wales and parts of southern England, with thunderstorms occurring in the west Midlands and Hampshire.</p> |

An area of low pressure, brought heavy rain across all places south of a line from Anglesey to The Wash, with the exception of Devon and Cornwall which stayed mainly dry with some sunshine. <i>Brize Norton in Oxfordshire recorded 115mm between approximately 0600 and 1800 UTC, and some places received 30–40mm in a single hour. There was significant disruption to road and rail transport, and flash-flooding brought chaos from South Wales to the Thames Valley area.</i></p> <p>In comparison, Scotland, Northern Ireland and northern England had a much quieter day with a good deal of sunshine. Although the rain across southern areas pushed into northern England during the late afternoon and early evening. Winds were generally light, although they were quite gusty across some central and southern parts of England. A broad band of rain covered most of southern England, stretching from Cornwall northeast towards The Wash. The rain was not particularly heavy but it was persistent, although by lunchtime it did begin to peter out somewhat especially in the southeast where there some drier and brighter spells. The showers were frequent and heavy at times in the north and tended to become more frequent in the southeast towards evening. Showers over Northern Ireland and Cumbria died away to leave a largely dry and fairly sunny afternoon. Across the rest of England and Wales it was a dry, bright morning with some sunshine, but thickening cloud in the afternoon brought rain to Cornwall and Pembrokeshire by 1600 UTC. The rain quickly extended to the rest of Wales and southwest England by early evening and to much of southern England, the Midlands and London by late evening. The rain became persistent and quite heavy in places with rates around 3–4mm per hour in Wales and the south. Fresh to strong westerly winds across southern Scotland and northeast England died away in the evening.<br/> Afternoon temperatures were below normal in the north — generally around 17 °C in Scotland and Northern Ireland, around 18 °C or 19 °C in northern England but reaching a high of 22 °C across the Midlands and the South.</p> |
